Turquoise Positive numbers indicate that the difference between basis skills and non-basic skills success rates have narrowed in fall 2013 compared to fall 2011.

Rose Negative numbers indicate that the difference between basis skills and non-basic skills success rates have widened in fall 2013 compared to fall 2011.

Olive Although success rates by basic skills student were higher than for non-basic skills students in both terms, the difference between rates was lower in fall 2013.
