Twenty Barrier/High-Risk Courses - Increase in Numbers of Successful Hispanic Students

The twenty high-risk/barrier courses appearing in the Title V-Velocidad Grant were identified using success rate data for the fall 2010/spring 2011 terms, which serve as the grant's baseline rates.

In the table below, overall success rates for Hispanic students in the twenty high-risk/barrier courses are displayed by fall/spring terms from 2011-2012 to 2014-2015. Column (A) indicates the actual numbers of successful students in each fall/spring period; Column (B) depicts numbers of successful students calculated using the baseline success rate of $55.2 \%$. Column (C) shows the increase in the numbers of successful students. Since the implementation of the Velocidad Grant, see 2012-2015.
