Groups report-out on findings: 2018- 2019 group and 2017-2018 group	 Following discussion, the "19-20" and "20-21" budget taskforce workgroups reported to the committee their findings as it relates to the "19-22" SEA Budget Plan. The committee met in December and concerns were raised regarding the SEA budget spending being aligned with the 19-22 SEA Plan. Two work groups were formed to go over the 19-20 and 20-21 SEA budgets and they reported back their findings to such concerns as: a. Why is there funding in areas where there is currently no action happening? b. There needs to be more transparency shown. Who is reviewing the plan? c. How are student objectives being met through the initiatives? d. Is the SEA budget connected to the Equity Plan? Also. the committee formed a taskforce group to prioritize the "Expanded Activities" on pages 10-14 of the Equity Plan. The purpose is to determine which activities would be the committee's main "Equity" focus. B. Herrera read the following to the committee and asked that it be included in the minutes: Attached is our review of the SSC budget for the FY 2019-2020. We used the FYSOTRN budget format for this budget review. Our group found it challenging to match the expenditures to the actual initiatives written in the approved VC Equity Plan for 2019-2022 because the following items—which are important to note—were missing data elements such as: 1. The budget lacked specificity in terms of no positions noted, no names provided for each area

BTBG, CDW Govt, etc) 3. No percentage given on how much (%) is set aside for Health Benefits for each position. 4. The indication which area (ex. Counseling, Pirates Cove, etc) was working on which initiative and what outcomes are expected to be achieved. 5. Some accounts have unused funds. Why? Did it get rollover to another SEA account? Was it used? K. Algiers spoke regarding hosting an Equity Summit Series. She shared that to kick the series off, Long Beach City College will address their equity gaps through a virtual Cultural Curriculum Audit to be held January 29th from 9-10 a.m. Speakers will include subjects regarding Equity in Social Justice and will include subjects regarding Equity in Social Justice.
