# Background

### Students

- ➤ 70% of all Ventura College students are designated low-income students
- ► 50% of students are food insecure
- ► 18% of students are housing insecure

### Housing Grant

- ► Housing for low income, full-time (12 units or more) students
- October 2021 grant application (six-week application period)
- ▶ June 2022 Legislature allocated \$62.9 million for VC project
- Visited Senates, ASVC and College Area Community Council





### **Current Status**

- ▶ Oct 11, 2022 Ventura County Board of Supervisors approved VC application for \$3 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds
- Geotechnical survey is complete
- California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) compliance report is complete
- Request for Proposals/Qualifications (RFP/Q) for Project/Construction Management firm due March 8, 2023
- Request for Proposals (RFP) for Architect firm to be developed as soon as project/construction management firm hired
- VC Facilities Oversight Group will be liaison between the campus community and the project/construction management and architect firms

Hire the Architect	May - August 2023	
Planning and Design	August 2023 - February 2024	
Plan Submittal and Review	February 2024 - February 2025	
Construction	March 2025 - August 2026	
Occupancy	August 2026	
Student, Employee and Community Input	Throughout the process



# What is Dual Enrollment?



Allows eligible K-12 students

to take college classes while they are still enrolled in high school.



**Provides students an opportunity** 

to get a head start on their higher education goals.



Students can take advantage of

not paying enrollment fees - all other fees apply.

# Students can receive the following benefits from participating in dual enrollment:

Introduction to and preparation for college life

Ability to explore interests, careers, and majors

Motivation to stick with it and pursue a college degree or certificate


Understanding the benefits of college education

# 5,291 forms processed Jan 2022 to Feb 2023


# Classes Cleared

# **Ventura College**

- Present to HS Counselors at the High School Counselor Exchange.
- Partner VC Coaches to help with Dual Enrollment Outreach.
- Update counselors regarding workshop attendees to allow on-time clearances for registration.



# **High School**

- Scheduled in-person workshops 1-2 months prior to registration.
- Follow-up with students that have not completed the dual enrollment forms.
- Update counselors regarding workshop attendees to allow on-time clearances for registration.

# How is Admissions & Records helping Dual Enrollment Students?



## **Middle School**

- Connected with approximately 180 counselors and principals in Ventura County to inform them of Ventura College's Summer and Fall 2023 registration.
- Offered in-person dual enrollment workshops for 8th graders moving into 9th grade.
- Provided student and parent dual enrollment guides.


# **Elementary School**

- Create a welcome letter to Ventura College for 6th graders.
- Supply dual enrollment posters and flyers for parents and students.
- Be present early so students are aware of dual enrollment.
