It reports and makes recommendations to the Vice President of Business Services and the Budget and Resource Council (BRC). In addition, the Advisory Group reviews the plan annually, makes recommendations for revisions as needed, ranks priority of technology spending based on program review data, and serves as a forum for discussing campus technology issues.
