Spring 2016 – Ventura College Textbook Lending Library

INTRODUCTION

This report presents aggregate demographic data related to students who borrowed textbooks on <u>January 6, 2016</u> from the Ventura College Textbook Lending Library. To formulate a list of individuals who were receiving books from the Lending Library, staff asked students to write their name and VCCCD ID on their Lending Library Lottery Ticket. On <u>January 7</u>, students were permitted to borrow books on a "first-come, first-served" basis; no Lottery Ticket was required. As such, VCCCD IDs were not obtained from students who received books on January 7th.

The Lottery Tickets collected on January 6th were delivered to Felicia Torres, Administrative Assistant at the Office of Institutional Equity and Effectiveness, who entered the VCCCD IDs into an Excel file. Although 491 Tickets were provided, only 448 were matched to spring 2016 Banner records (see table below).

SUMMARY

The average **spring 2016 GPA**, **Attempted Units**, and **Earned Units** are all **higher** for VC students who used the Lending Library than for all other VC students. It is important to note that users of the Lending Library may have also participated in one/more student success, student services, student support or special programs.

On the next page, students who used the Lending Library are compared to students who did not use the Lending Library. Comparisons are made on the following five demographic characteristics: Ethnicity, Gender, Age Group, Enrollment Status, and BOGW Status.

In the table below, demographic groups with the <u>highest</u> percentages of Lending Library users are compared to the percentages of non-users within the same groups. For example, the Ethnic Group with the largest percentage of Lending Library users was Hispanics, at 72%. The percentage of Hispanics among non-users of the Lending Library was 58%. The difference between the percentages of Hispanics who used the Lending Library and those who didn't is 14 percentage points.
