**Fall 2010 – Students Enrolled in VC Classes at the East Campus or Fillmore HS**

■ **INTRODUCTION**

Ventura College offers off-campus classes at **two** locations in the **Santa Clara River Valley (SCRV)**. The **SCRV** extends eastward along State Highway 126 from **Santa Paula** through **Fillmore** to **Piru**, terminating at the Los Angeles County line.

The Ventura College **East Campus (EC)**, situated in **Santa Paula** in its own facility, is currently offering **27** courses (**32** sections). VC also offers classes at **Fillmore High School (FHS)**. Currently, there are **nine** courses (**11** sections) being offered at **FHS**. VC classes at the **EC** and **FHS** provide local access to college classes for residents of the Santa Clara River Valley.

At census (September 7, 2010), there were **575** students at the **East Campus** and **206** students enrolled in VC classes at **Fillmore High School**. Many of these students were enrolled in multiple courses as indicated in **Table A** (below). Total VC course enrollments (seatcount) at the **EC** were **676** and at **FHS** were **245**.

■ **DEMOGRAPHICS OF SCR V STUDENTS**

**Table B** (below) and **Table C** (page 2) provide demographic information about students enrolled at the two SCR V sites. **Table B** indicates the ethnic and gender composition of students at each site. The predominant ethnicity at both locations is **Hispanic: 78%** at the **EC** and **72%** at **FHS**. **Females** are the majority gender at the **EC (76%)** and also at **FHS (65%)**.
