District Changes in Technology Administration	Tom reported that Dave Fuhrmann is no longer with Prism but is now with Strata Information Group and has been recently appointed as the District Chief Technology Officer. Dwayne Cable will continue working with us to get the Distance Ed platform up and running and assist with the web site redesign project. Tom also reported that we have not been able to move forward with the staffing plan which called for hiring an Information Technology Director because the District has yet to decide what the level of the position should be. Review/Approval of Refresh Phase I	Craig reviewed the refresh plan which calls for replacement of 25% of the computers each year over the next 4 years. There are approximately 1400 computers on campus. The deployment strategy is to be sure that computers used by students are as current as possible. Faculty should use the same computers as in their labs. Replaced computers less than four years old can be repurposed elsewhere on campus. The plan is to remove 350 old PCs from the inventory each year. A quote was received from Dell for 356 computers and 161 LCD monitors with a 4 year			

	<p>warranty which will be going to the Board for approval at their May meeting. They should start to arrive on campus at the end of May. A meeting was held with the campus techs and a proposed distribution list for the first 350 computers was presented to the committee for approval. After review, the list was approved by the committee as presented.</p>			
<p>Revised Plan Update: Fall 2007</p>	<p>Since the plan was approved, Dave has been meeting with the technology staff to initiate its implementation. There are a few minor revisions that need to be made to the plan and they will be presented to the committee at its next meeting in the Fall semester.</p>			<p>Dave and technology staff</p>
<p>Interactive White Boards (Art Sandford)</p>	<p>Art asked if there was a standard for interactive white boards. He explained that with the interactive white boards you can make notations right on the screen while projecting. He uses it a lot and other instructors have become interested in using one also. Dave commented that in his next meeting with the IT staff, he will put it on the agenda to develop a district wide standard. He said if there is a particular one that is being used, they could adopt it as the standard. Art will get the information on the one he has to Dave.</p>			<p>Dave and IT staff</p>

- Develop Service Level Agreements (SLAs)
- Work on "smart" classroom upgrades for 2007-2008

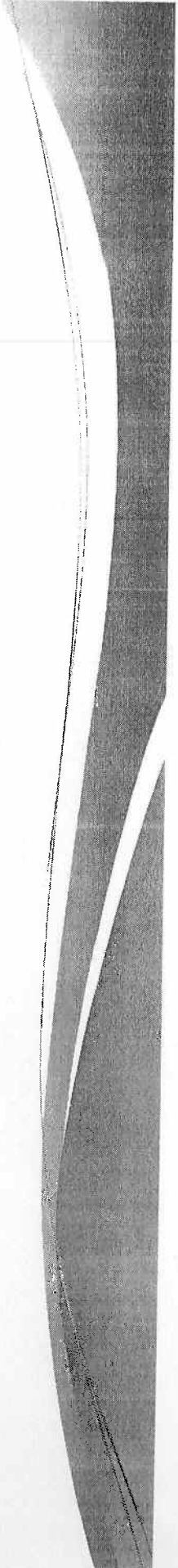

Technology Refresh Strategy

- Replace 25% of computers each year
- Approximately 1400 computers on campus
- 350 computers ordered each year
- Migrate all monitors to LCD flat panels which will last 7 – 10 years

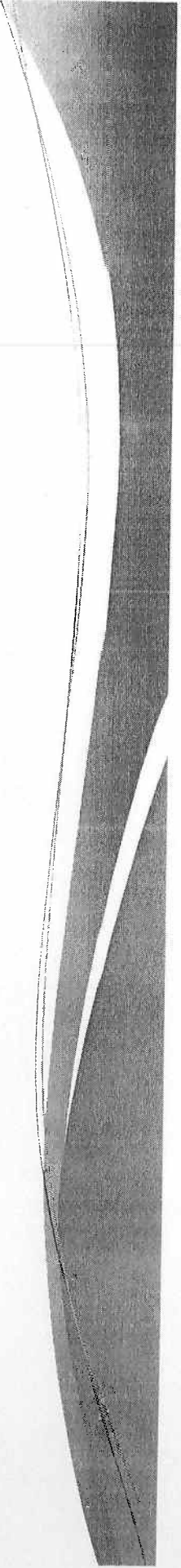


Deployment Strategy

- Computers used by students should be as current as possible
- Faculty should use the same computers as in their labs
