4.	SSC and CPC Process	There was discussion regarding how the process works when a recommendation is made. J. Kalfsbeek-Goetz said recommendations are submitted to the President of Executive Team then it goes to CPC. If there are any changes or questions, CPC will send recommendation back to SSC. If no changes or questions, the recommendation will either be approved or rejected. R. Fernandez and D. Clark said they will be advocates for the SSC in the CPC meeting. D. 5.	Review of the SEA Budget (with line items) and the status of AY 19-20 Funded Projects	P. Munoz shared her concern about the equity plan and after looking at the budget it appears nothing has been budgeted yet. J. Kalfsbeek-Goetz shared the equity committee met and is currently reviewing the budget and		

the SSC can make recommendations to the committee if budget items are not well aligned. Concerns and questions were made on the following: a. What will the funding be in 2021 from the approved 2019-2020 equity plan? b. Why is there funding in areas where there is currently no action happening? c. There needs to be more transparency shown. Who is reviewing the plan? d. How are student objectives being met through the initiatives? e. Is the SEA budget connected to the equity plan? f. Why is there \$1,000,000 being budgeted under "Other General Institutional Support? P. Munoz recommended that work groups be formed to review the concerns and come back to SSC meeting with their findings. The committee discussed funding for initiatives, forming workgroups, reviewing SEA budget, and looking further at the equity plan to see what got funded. J. Kalfsbeek-Goetz added that the SSC should be making recommendations for Spring, but should also be focused on FY 2022 to help alleviate future frustration. B. Herrera asked for clarification on what is student engagement. J. Kalfsbeek-Goetz said any services coming out of Student Affairs/Student Services is called student engagement and she said C. Bojorquez will attend one of our SSC meetings to assist with clarification of questions.
