

#### **Student Plans and Preferences Survey**

To assist with Covid-related planning, IE surveyed students about their plans and preferences for fall and spring. The survey was sent via text message on Aug 12, 2021, to all students who were enrolled in a fall 2021 VC class, and who had not opted out of receiving non-emergency text messages. The survey was also sent via text message on Aug 16, 2021 to all students who had previously enrolled in a VC class in spring 2020, fall 2020, or spring 2021, but had not enrolled in a fall 2021 class. The survey was completed by 1,006 currently-enrolled students, and 255 previously-enrolled students. Data are not displayed in cells with fewer than 10 students. Students were assured that their answers would be kept anonymous.
