The Office of Institutional Equity and Effectiveness (IEE) provides high-quality data and analysis to inform college decisions. We provide leadership in the areas of institutional research, college planning, and program review.

Student Equity Plan

In 2014, the State of California began to provide formal funding to colleges for the specific purpose of closing gaps in access and success among underrepresented groups. This funding stipulates that each college must develop an annual student equity plan, in which the college analyzes data on five key equity metrics, identifies gaps between student groups, and then develops interventions to close those gaps.



The Community College Survey of Student Engagement (CCSSE)

VC is conducting the CCSSE this spring. This survey provides us with valuable information on student engagement, which is a key indicator of learning. 52 sections containing approximately 1,600 students have been randomly selected to participate.
