Dear Faculty,

I hope you had a nice holiday break and welcome back to 2017. I am emailing this afternoon to make you aware of a problem with reporting **Last Day of Attendance (LDA**). If you are included as a blind copy on this email, then you had one or more students who you recorded a grade of "F" with a last day attendance prior to census.

It is a requirement for Financial Aid is to have a record the last day of attendance. Faculty are asked to provide this day for students when you submitted your grades. Recording this day is important and effects college reimbursement for Financial Aid and apportionment. Unfortunately, when this day was recorded in Fall, many faculty listed <u>a date prior to census</u> for students' LDA. The result will be that the college will lose almost \$130,000 in attendance apportionment funds. This is an example of why LDA date is very important and why it is essential that your rosters be accurate for census reporting. The lesson learned here is that we need your help with the following:

- **4** Ensuring your rosters match enrollment on Census Day
- **4** Dropping any student who does not or rarely attends class before Census Day
- **4** Taking daily attendance to accurately record students Last Day of Attendance
