Colleagues,

Each year we are improving and upgrading our smart classroom technology on campus. As we move forward to digital learning environments, we are focusing on the future of media that will be used in the classroom setting.

As we upgrade our smart classrooms on campus, the focus of these rooms will center on digital media (DVD, BluRay, Streaming, YouTube, etc). We realize that some instructors are still using VHS tapes for their curriculum and we would like to help with this transition.

To help with this transition to digital media:

- Work with your dean to get your VHS tapes converted or replaced.
- Check for your content that may have already been uploaded to YouTube.

Moving forward, all new smart classroom upgrades at Ventura College will not include VHS tape players. We will continue to support the VHS players that are currently in some of our smart classrooms. But, when they fail they will not be replaced. All DVD's can be played on the existing PC's that are included with each smart classroom.

This new smart class room standard was started in all of the Applied Sciences classrooms. These classrooms do not have VHS tape players, but DVD and Blu-ray players are available.
