Accreditation Update	The Strategic Technology Plan 2017-2020 was presented at CPC. There were no problems. BRC is next. The Group reviewed rubric for FY17/18 initiatives.	
Assessment Center	Some locations were discussed including the MCE drafting lab and ELC	
Strategic Technology Plan 2017-2020	Grant introduced the latest version for all to review. The plan includes a 5-year refresh cycle. Focus on students' needs. Ask, "How does it help students?" FY16/17 there were no initiatives except the basic tech refresh. Standardizing smart classrooms is efficient. Fiscal Year 17-18 there will be about \$1,000,000+ worth of projects. Not all will be funded.
