■ INTRODUCTION

The **Spring 2014 Accelerated Learning Program** offered fast-paced instruction in special sections of **English** and **Mathematics**. The Program's objectives are:

- (1) To enable students to successfully complete two courses in either English or Mathematics within one semester, thus allowing them to enroll in the next level English or Mathematics course in the succeeding semester
- (2) To increase the retention (semester-to-semester enrollment) and academic progress of students who enter Ventura College requiring basic skills instruction in English or Mathematics.

English Component

Success rate in accelerated ENGL V02 was <u>lower</u> than the rate in all other sections of the course.
