■ **SUMMARY**

• Introduction

The Ventura College **Writing Center** (WC) is located in the Learning Resource Center, Room LRC-160 (inside the Tutoring Center) and is funded through the college's Title V *Velocidad* Grant. The WC assists students at all levels in acquiring the foundational skills they need to improve their reading strategies, grammatical and rhetorical accuracy in academic writing, and confidence as learners.

The center's purpose is to support classroom instruction by offering students free, one-on-one faculty workshops, peer tutoring, and directed learning activities as a way to reinforce skills expected of students in college courses. The WC is open to all Ventura College students.

This report relates students who visited the WC in **fall 2015**. Data for the study were extracted from GradesFirst (WC tutoring sessions) and the VCCCD Banner System (final grades).

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■ SUCCESS RATE COMPARISONS

This table compares the course success rates of tutored students to those of non-tutored students in courses where **four or more** students received tutoring. The non-tutored students were enrolled in the **same** course **sections** as the tutored students.

Most students who visited the Reading/Writing Center received tutoring related to their enrollment in an **English composition course**:

ENGL V01A: Success rate for tutored students is 28% higher than for the non-tutored students.
 ENGL V01B: Success rate for tutored students is 5% higher than for the non-tutored students.
 ENGL V02: Success rate for tutored students is 20% higher than for the non-tutored students.
 ENGL V03: Success rate for tutored students is 7% lower than for the non-tutored students.
