Spring 2015 - Reading and Writing Center

■ **SUMMARY**

Introduction

In spring 2015, the Ventura College **Reading and Writing Center** (RWC) was located in the Learning Resource Center, Room LRC-155 and was funded through the college's Title V *Velocidad* Grant. The RWC assists students at all reading/writing levels in acquiring the foundational skills they need to improve their reading strategies, grammatical and rhetorical accuracy in academic writing, and confidence as learners.

The center's purpose is to support classroom instruction by offering students free, one-on-one faculty workshops, peer tutoring, and directed learning activities as a way to reinforce skills expected of students in college courses.

The study period consists of the **spring 2015** term. Data for the study were extracted from GradesFirst (RWC tutoring sessions) and the VCCCD Banner System (final grades).

Overview

Demographics of Tutored Students

- Ethnicity: Hispanic students accounted for the greatest percentage of tutored students: 65%.
- **Gender:** The majority of tutored students were **female**: **57**%.

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■ <u>SUCCESS RATES BY COURSE</u>

Several of the **381** individual students who received services through the Reading/Writing Center were tutored in **more** than one course (a total of **399**). Of these **399**, **383** received a grade in the course and **342** of them were successful outcomes. Success is defined as a grade of A, B, C, or P.

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■ <u>SUCCESS RATE COMPARISONS</u>

This table compares the course success rates of tutored students to those of non-tutored students in courses where **20 or more** students received tutoring. The non-tutored students were enrolled in the **same** course **sections** as the tutored students.

Most students who visited the Reading/Writing Center received tutoring related to their enrollment in an **English composition course**:

ENGL V01A: Success rate for tutored students is **23%** *higher* than for the non-tutored students.

ENGL V02: Success rate for tutored students is **32%** *higher* than for the non-tutored students.

ENGL V03: Success rate for tutored students is **11%** *higher* than for the non-tutored students.

Of the **twenty-five** (25) **POLS V01** students who visited the RWC, **92%** were successful versus **71%** for the students who did not receive RWC tutoring.
