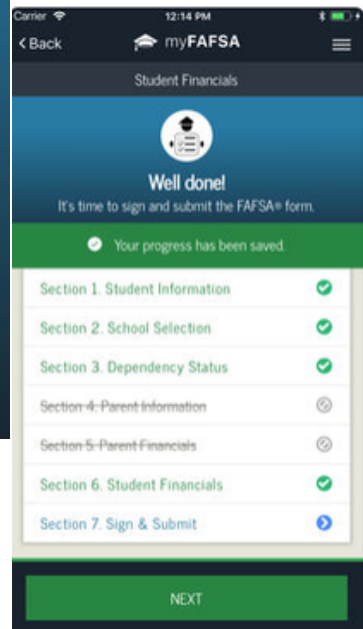
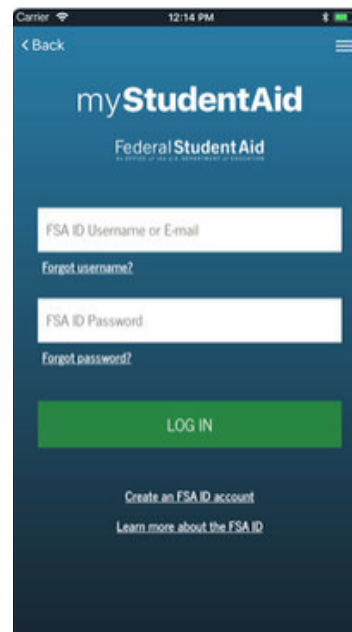

What is CalFresh?

The CalFresh program, formerly known as Food Stamps and federally known as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), can add to your food budget to put healthy and nutritious food on the table.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for CalFresh as a student, you must be between the ages of 18 and 49, enrolled in at least 6 units, and meet any ONE of the requirements listed at www.venturacollege.edu/calfresh.

Day One - Priority Day - Be the first to see what's available!

- 1) Log into your VCCCD Student Portal anytime between Thursday, 11/1/2018 through Tuesday, 1/1/2019
- 2) Click on the "My College" tab, scroll to the "Student QuickLinks" section and click on "Scholarship Application"
- 3) Complete the "FREE Textbooks Spring 2019" Application
- 4) In the confirmation message and/or email that follows, follow the link to sign up for the time you'd like to come by on the Priority Day, Thursday, January 3rd. (Four time periods, 1 hour each, 250 students per period)
- 5) Join us at the LRC during your selected time period (step #4 just above) on 1/3/2019 and bring your class schedule, photo ID, and printed booklist.

Day Two - Friday, January 4, 2019 from 2pm-4pm

- First-come, first-served basis
- No application required

- Three (3) Textbook Limit per student

(FIRST THINGS FIRST)

1. AT NIGHT ON A 3x5 CARD WRITE DOWN 5 OF THE MOST IMPORTANT TASKS YOU HAVE TO DO TOMORROW.
2. NUMBER THEM IN ORDER OF IMPORTANCE.
3. IN THE MORNING, LOOK AT TASK 1 AND GET STARTED ON IT UNTIL IT'S COMPLETE.
4. PROCEED TO STEP 2 UNTIL IT'S COMPLETE AND THEN TO STEP 3.
5. EACH NIGHT WRITE A NEW LIST ON A 3X5 CARD.
