

■ **INTRODUCTION**

The intent of this report is to provide Ventura College professional staff with the background data and baseline information that is necessary to develop a meaningful survey of the post-secondary educational aspirations of Santa Clara River Valley residents. The Santa Clara River Valley (SCRV) encompasses the cities of Fillmore and Santa Paula and includes the unincorporated area of Piru. Population data for these three residential areas were obtained from the U.S. Census Bureau's website. All of the Ventura College enrollment information was extracted from the VCCCD Banner System on November 21, 2006. Ventura College offers classes at three SCRV sites: the East Campus (Santa Paula), Fillmore High School, and Santa Paula High School. Enrollments data for SCRV high schools were obtained from CBEDS (California Basic Educational Data System).

• **Selected Demographics of the Santa Clara River Valley**

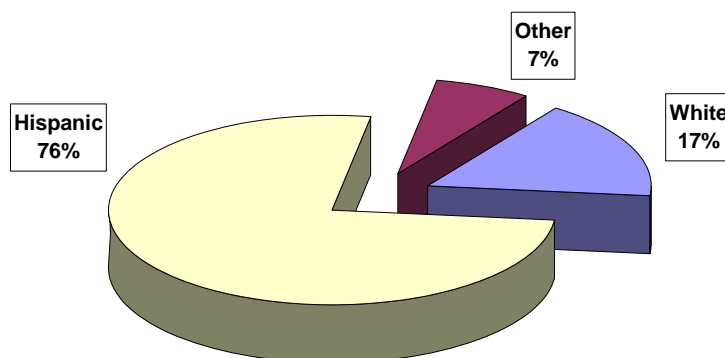
In **2005** the estimated population of the Santa Clara River Valley was **44,530** – **70%** were **Hispanic**.

Females accounted for **50%** of the population – **58%** of residents were **18 – 64 years** of age.

• **Santa Clara River Valley Residents Attending Ventura College**

In **fall 2006**, **1,942** residents of the Santa Clara River Valley were enrolled in classes at VC; of which **76%** (1,468) were **Hispanic**; **65%** (1,254) were **female**, and **88%** (1,700) were **18 – 64 years** of age. The ethnic percentages of SCRV residents at VC in fall 2006 are depicted in the chart.



• **College Participation Rates of Santa Clara River Valley Residents**

In regards to the **three** demographic characteristics cited above, residents of the Santa Clara River Valley are enrolled in Ventura College at **higher** percentages than their proportions in the SCRV.

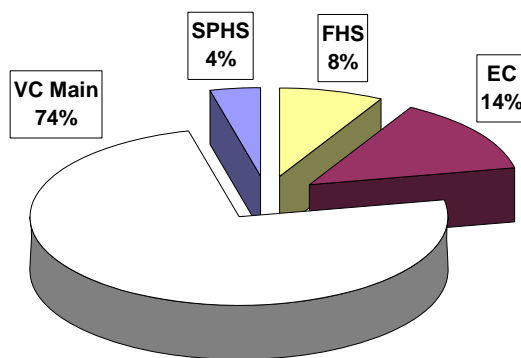

• VC Course Enrollments by Santa Clara River Valley Residents

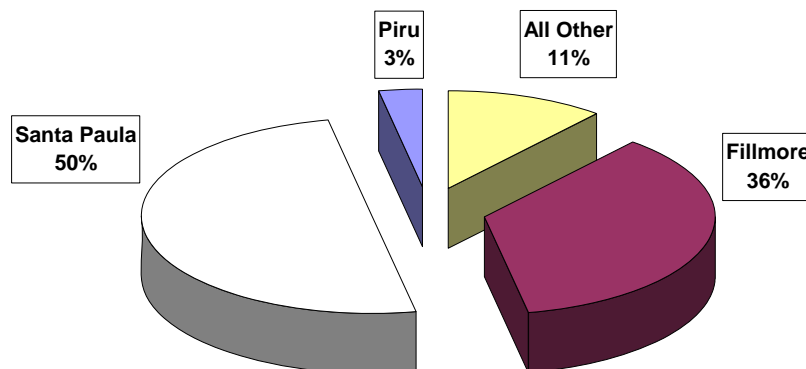

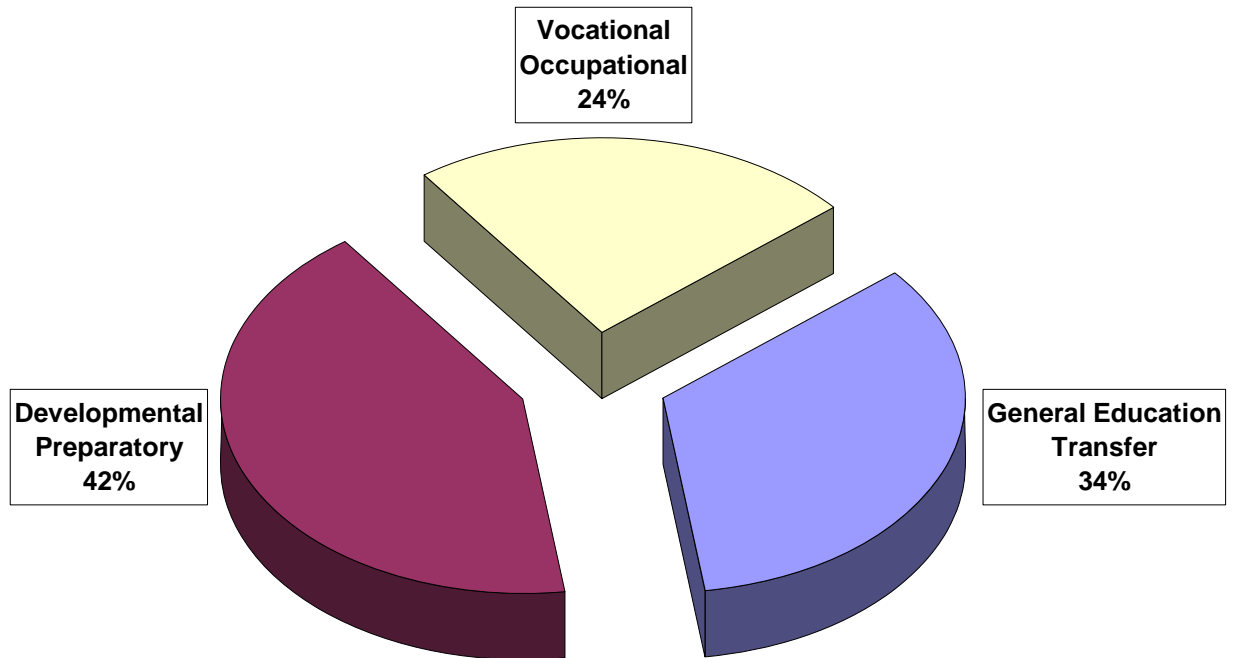
In **fall 2006**, there were **962** students enrolled in **1,134** courses at the three SCRV sites; **851 (89%)** of these students resided in the Santa Clara River Valley. The remaining **111 (11%)** lived in other geographical locations. The chart shows the percentages of students at SCRV sites that lived in Piru, Fillmore or Santa Paula. ■ **SANTA CLARA RIVER VALLEY – POPULATION STATISTICS**

• **Selected Demographics of the Santa Clara River Valley**

Population data related to the **three** Santa Clara River Valley residential areas were obtained from the U.S. Census Bureau website. Based on **Census 2000** data for these areas, the Census Bureau estimated the population for each area as of **2005** (Table A below, third column). To approximate (a) the **Hispanic populations** in these areas and (b) the numbers of residents that were between **18 and 64 years** of age in **2005**, appropriate percentages from 2000 were applied to the 2005 populations. For example, to estimate the number of Hispanics residing in Santa Paula in 2005, **28,478** (estimated population of Santa Paula in 2005) was multiplied by **71.2%** (the percentage, in 2000, of Santa Paula’s residents who were Hispanic), resulting in an estimate of **20,276** persons.

The aggregated percentages for all three areas of the Santa Clara River Valley are:

Hispanics: 70% [(30,981 divided by 44,530) times 100]

18 – 64 year olds: 58% [(25,686 divided by 44,530) times 100]

Females: 50% [the female-to-male ratio is virtually 50/50]

• **Santa Clara River Valley Residents Attending Ventura College**

In fall 2006, there were **1,942** residents of the Santa Clara River Valley enrolled at Ventura College, of which **1,468 (76%)** were **Hispanic**; **1,700 (88%)** were **18 – 64 years** old; and **1,254 (65%)** were **female**. In the table below, SCRIV residents enrolled at VC were aggregated by ethnic category.

• **Participation Rates of Santa Clara River Valley Residents**

Regarding the three demographic characteristics examined above, SCRIV residents were enrolled in VC at **higher** percentages than their proportions in the SCRIV – i.e., their **participation rates** were **greater** than **100%** (e.g., for Hispanics, 76% divided by 70% equals **108%**).

• Student and Course Enrollments at Santa Clara River Valley Sites

In **fall 2006**, there were **962** students enrolled in **1,134** courses at the three SCR V sites. Of these **962** students, **866** – or **90%** – resided in the Santa Clara River Valley. The remaining **96** students (**10%**) resided in Ventura, Oxnard, Port Hueneme or other geographical locations. **Table E**, below, presents data related to students enrolled at VC’s SCR V educational sites.

Students enrolled at SCR V sites were predominantly **Hispanic (85%)** and they accounted for **86%** of the **1,134** SCR V course enrollments. White (non-Hispanic) students were the second largest ethnic group comprising **9%** of all students and **8%** of all course enrollments. Nearly **one-third** of the students attending classes at an SCRVA site were **19 years** of age/younger; **49%** of the students were **under 25 years** old; and **63%** were **less than 30 years** of age.
