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INTRODUCTION

Basic Skills Accountability – Supplement to the ARCC Report, was prepared by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office and released to the colleges on **March 28, 2011**. The report can be accessed in an electronic format at the following hyperlink:

Data presented in the **Basic Skills Accountability 2010** report are **system-level**, i.e., the data were aggregated across the entire California Community College System (112 colleges). The Chancellor's Office has also provided **college-level** data tables in pdf files, which can be downloaded from the CCCCO website. Data specific to VC were extracted from those tables and are set forth in this report.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to present Ventura College basic skills data **together** with the associated system-level outcomes data from the Basic Skills Accountability 2010 report. Because the Chancellor's Office data for individual CCC's are line items (rows) in data tables that include **all** CCC's, Ventura College data had to be located (for each metric) and then entered into forms created for this report. It should be noted that because of the recent statewide recoding (i.e., CB21–Course-Prior-to-Transfer-Level and TOP Codes), some courses previously considered "basic skills" have lost that designation.

The **Basic Skills Accountability 2010** report contains **41** data tables; however, there are college-level data for only **34** of the system-level tables. To enable comparison of VC outcomes with system-level outcomes, system-wide data tables were copied from the Basic Skills Accountability 2010 report and pasted on the same page (in this report) as the VC data. The **Table of Contents** is on page 3.

At Ventura College, **Mathematics** and **English Writing** are the only two disciplines in which **both** <u>college-level</u> and <u>credit basic skills</u> courses were offered. VC offered substantially **fewer** basic skills sections – as a **percentage** of all sections in each discipline – than the statewide averages: **42%** less sections in Mathematics and **61%** less sections in English Writing.

At VC, basic skills FTES in **Mathematics** and **English Writing** were **lower** – as a *percentage* of total FTES in each discipline – than statewide: **59%** less in Math and **50%** less in English Writing.

<u>Assessment and Matriculation</u>

Percentage data for Ventura College are on-average considerably *less* favorable than the statewide percentages. Theoretically, changes have been made to the collection (at VC) and reporting (by the VCCCD) of data to the Chancellor's Office MIS in order to accurately document the levels of Assessment and Matriculation services provided by Ventura College.

• Student Progress, Persistence, and Performance

Progress

First-time students in 2001–2002 were divided into cohorts based on their "levels below transfer" course enrollments. These cohorts were tracked through 2008–2009 to ascertain their rates of progress to higher level coursework and rates of degree or certificate completions.

Persistence

First-time students in fall 2006, fall 2007, or fall 2008 were tracked to the next spring or fall term. Fall to Spring: The **fall 2008** VC persistence rate was the **same** as the state rate: **89%**.

Fall to Fall: The fall 2008 VC persistence rate was 7.5 points lower than the state rate of 73.9%.

<u>Student Performance</u>

Course Completion Rates: In all courses, VC's rates were the **same/higher** than the state rates. Improvement Rates: In credit basic skills, VC's rates were the **same/higher** than the state rates; however, for ESL courses, VC's rate was **much lower** than the state rate.
