To become a HHA, students must complete a state-approved education program such as Ventura College’s program and have California’s competency exam to become certified as a CNA. As the projections show, the need for Home Health Aides is growing substantially.

Home health aides (HHAs), also known as personal care aides, assist those who are disabled, chronically ill or cognitively impaired. They often help older adults who need assistance. As the aged increase in number, the projected need for home health aids increases. HHAs assist persons with daily living activities at the person’s home or in a care facility. Duties performed at a residence may include housekeeping (making beds, doing laundry) and preparing meals. They may advise families or those they assist regarding nutrition, cleanliness and household activities.
