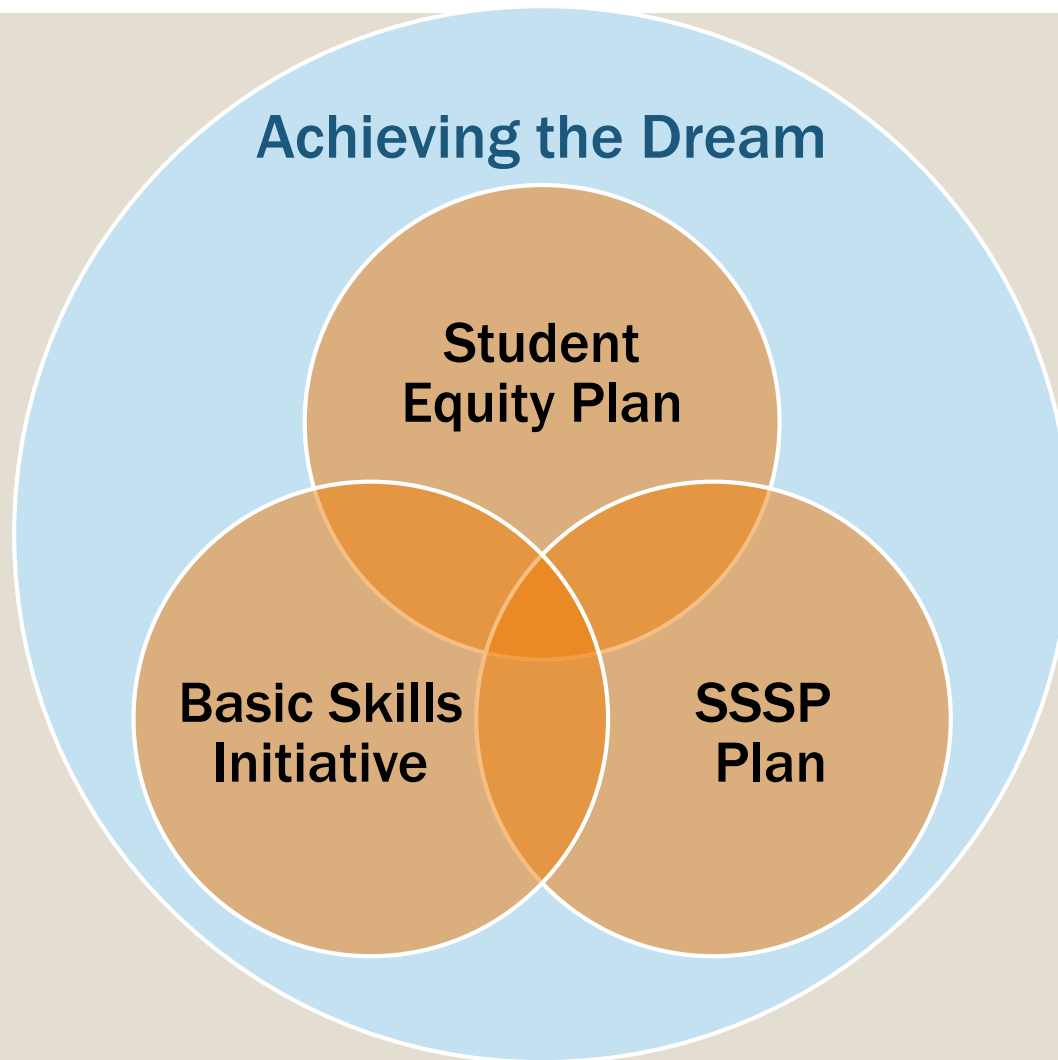

VC STUDENTS: WHO SUCCEEDS AND WHO LEAVES?



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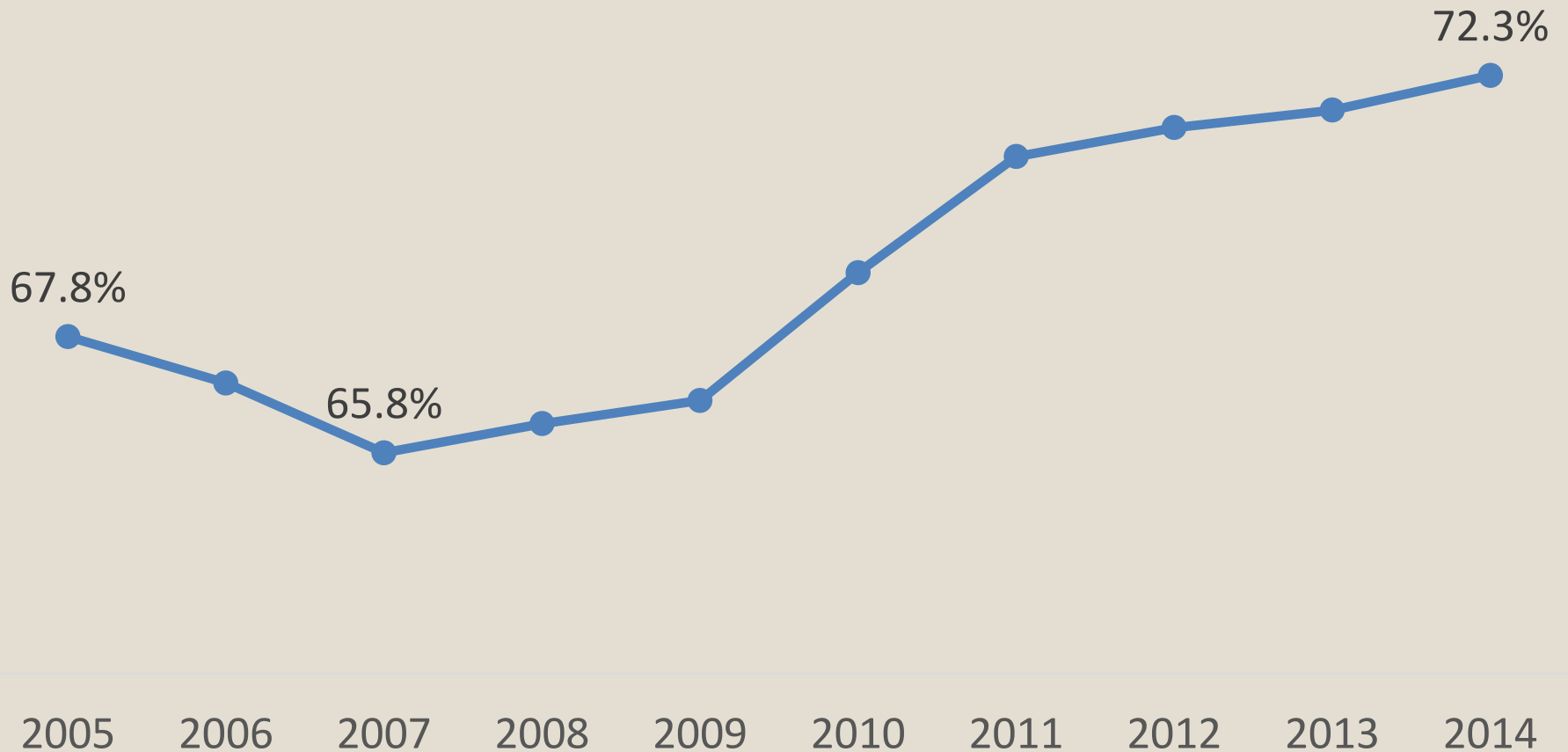

1. Completion of developmental courses
2. Completion of “gatekeeper” courses
3. Completion of all courses with a C or better
4. Fall-to-spring and fall-to-fall retention/persistence
5. Completion rate (degree or certificate)
 - Disaggregated by gender, ethnicity, Pell status, other subgroups

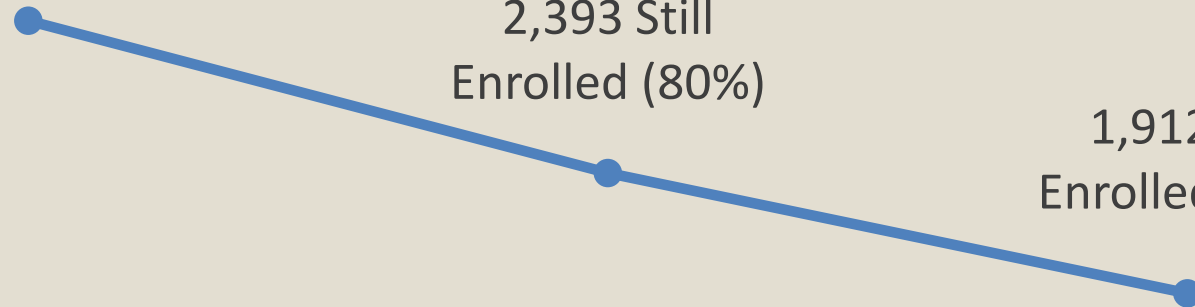

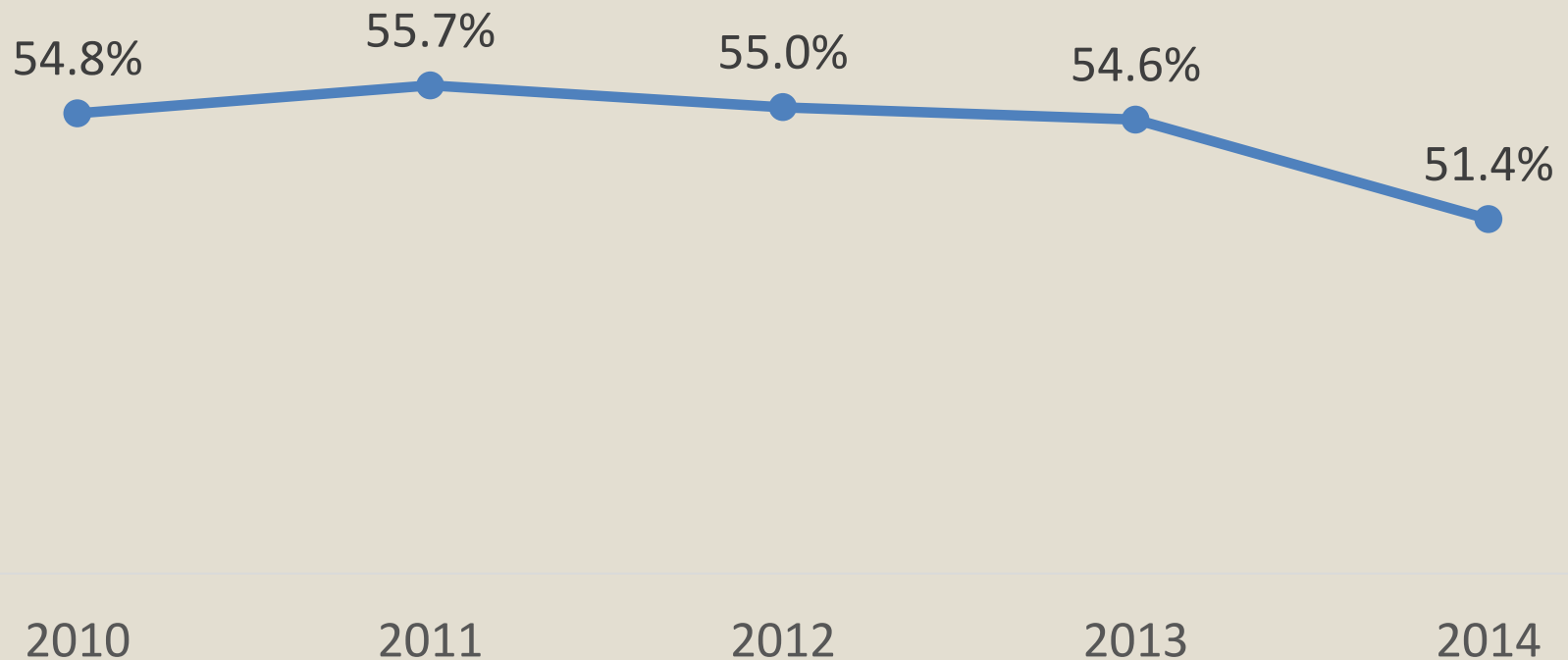

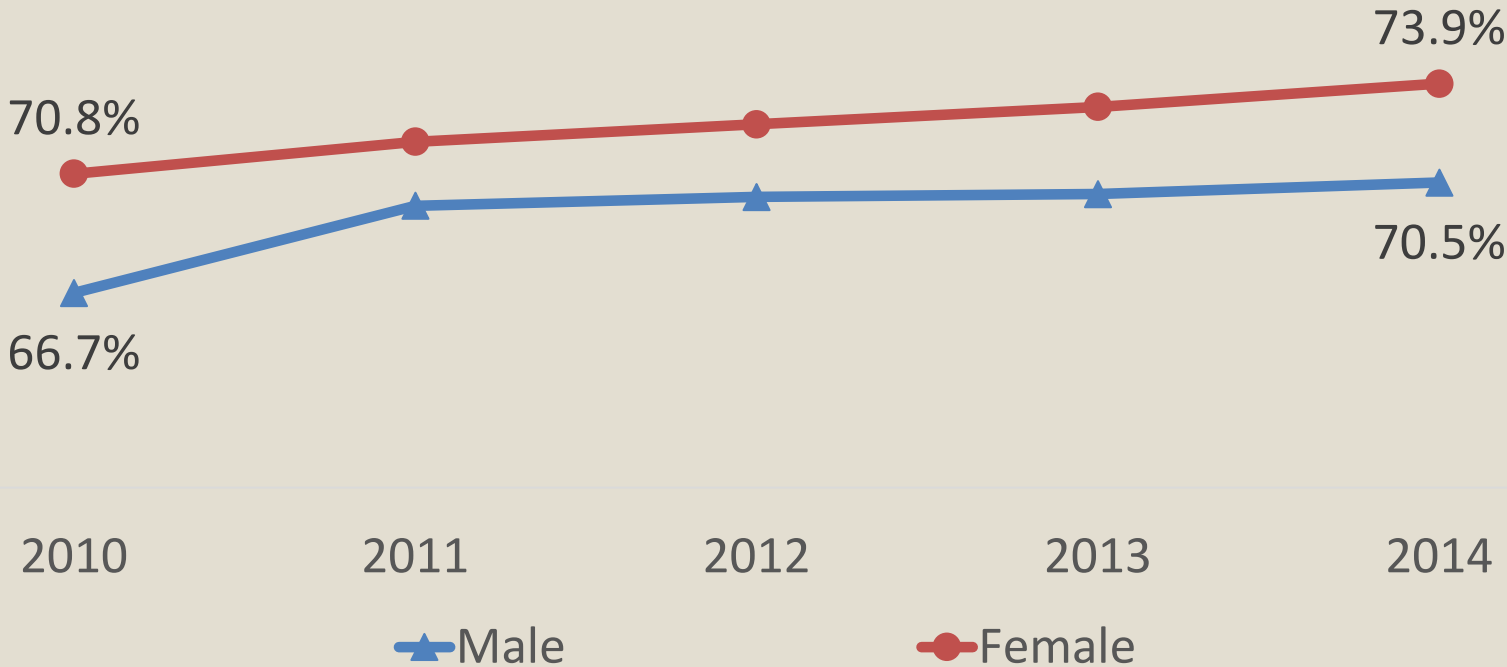


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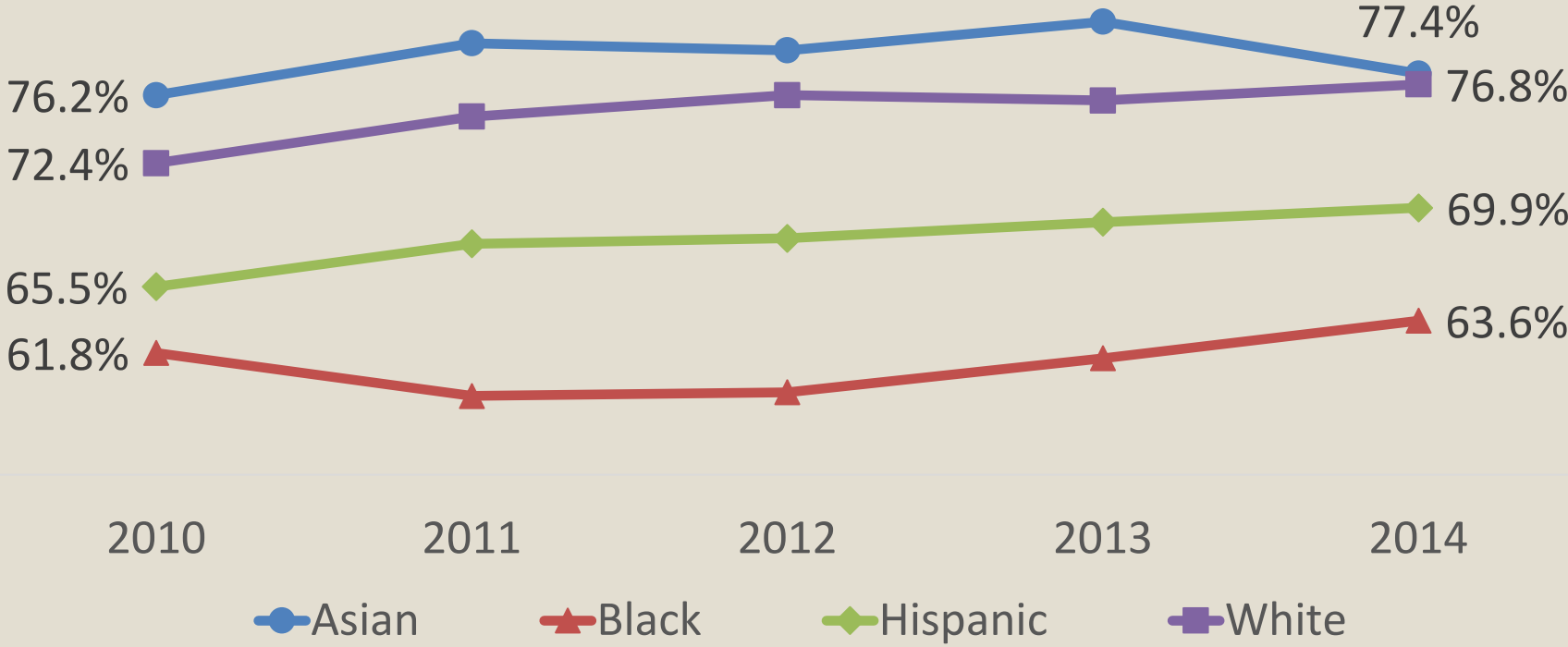
OVERALL COURSE COMPLETION BY GENDER

Fall Course Success Rate by Gender



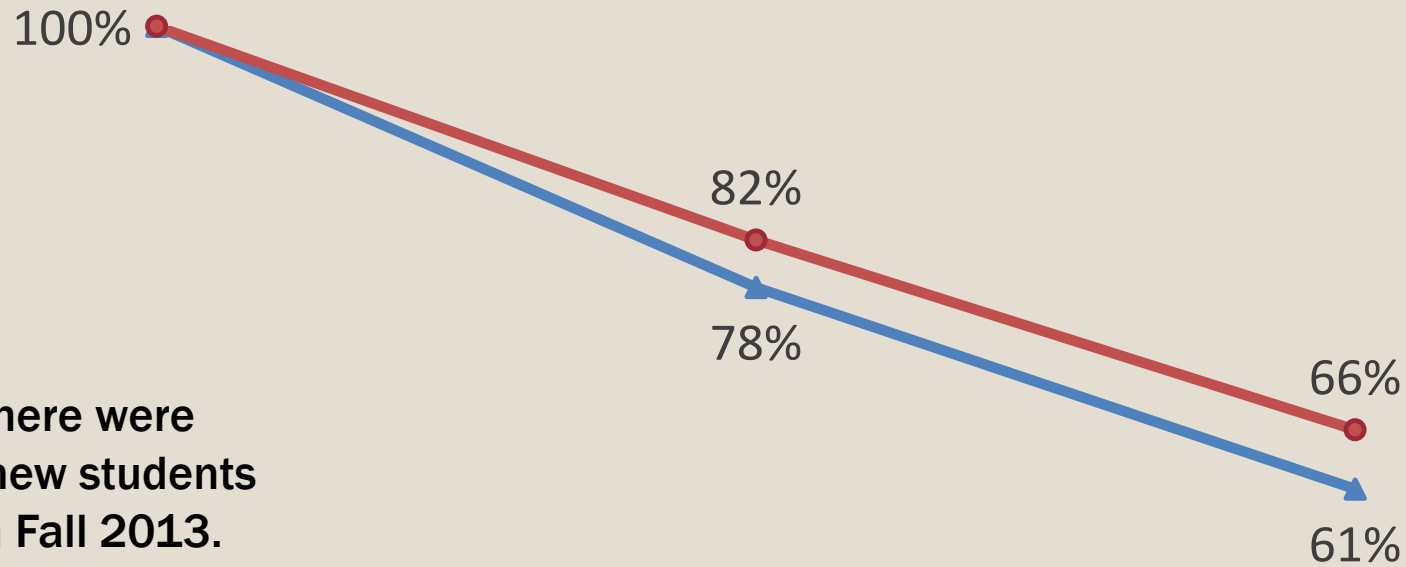
OVERALL COURSE COMPLETION BY RACE/ETHNICITY

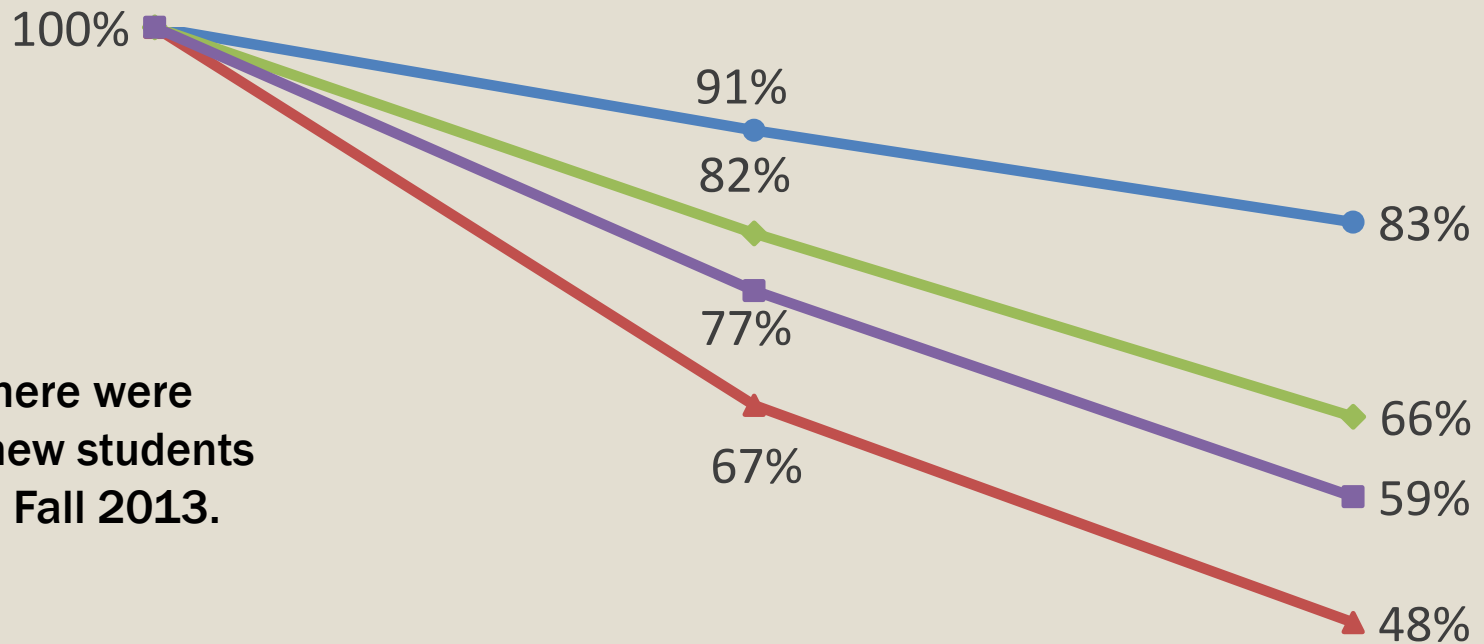

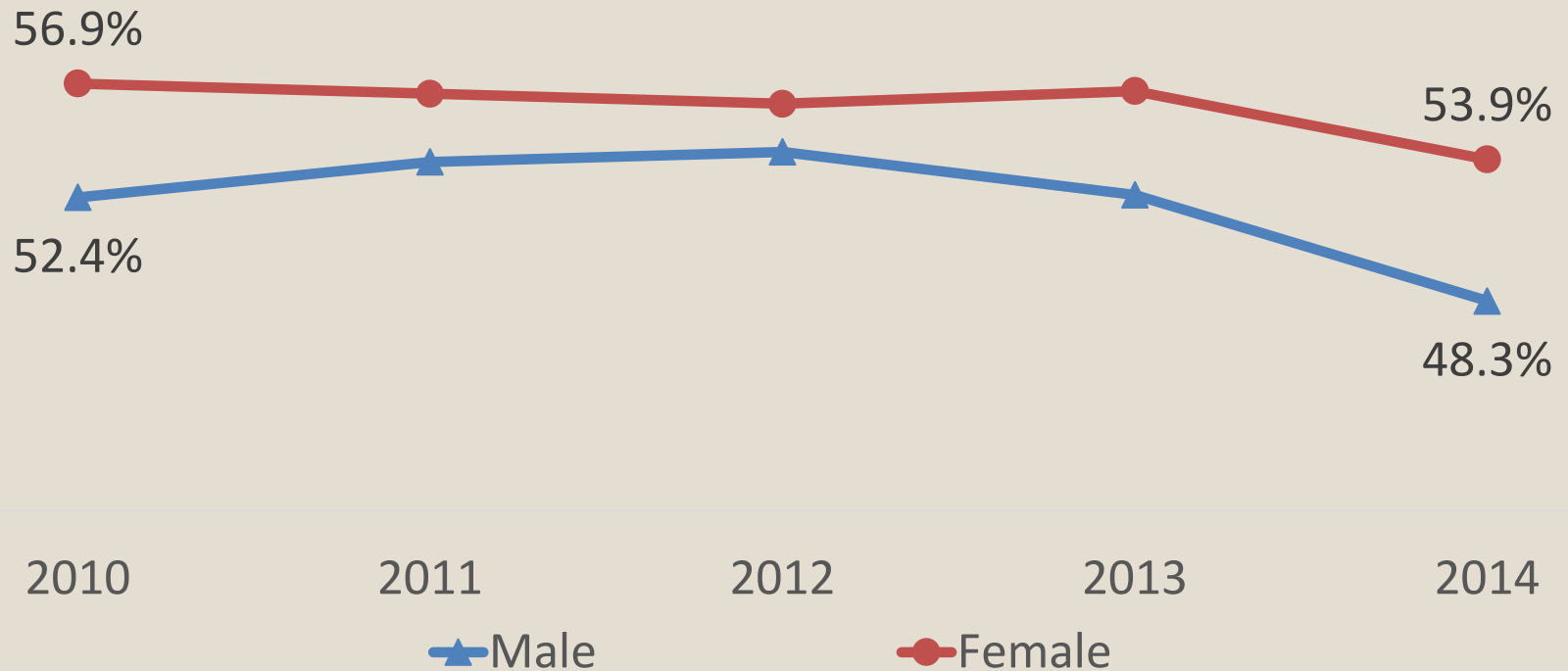

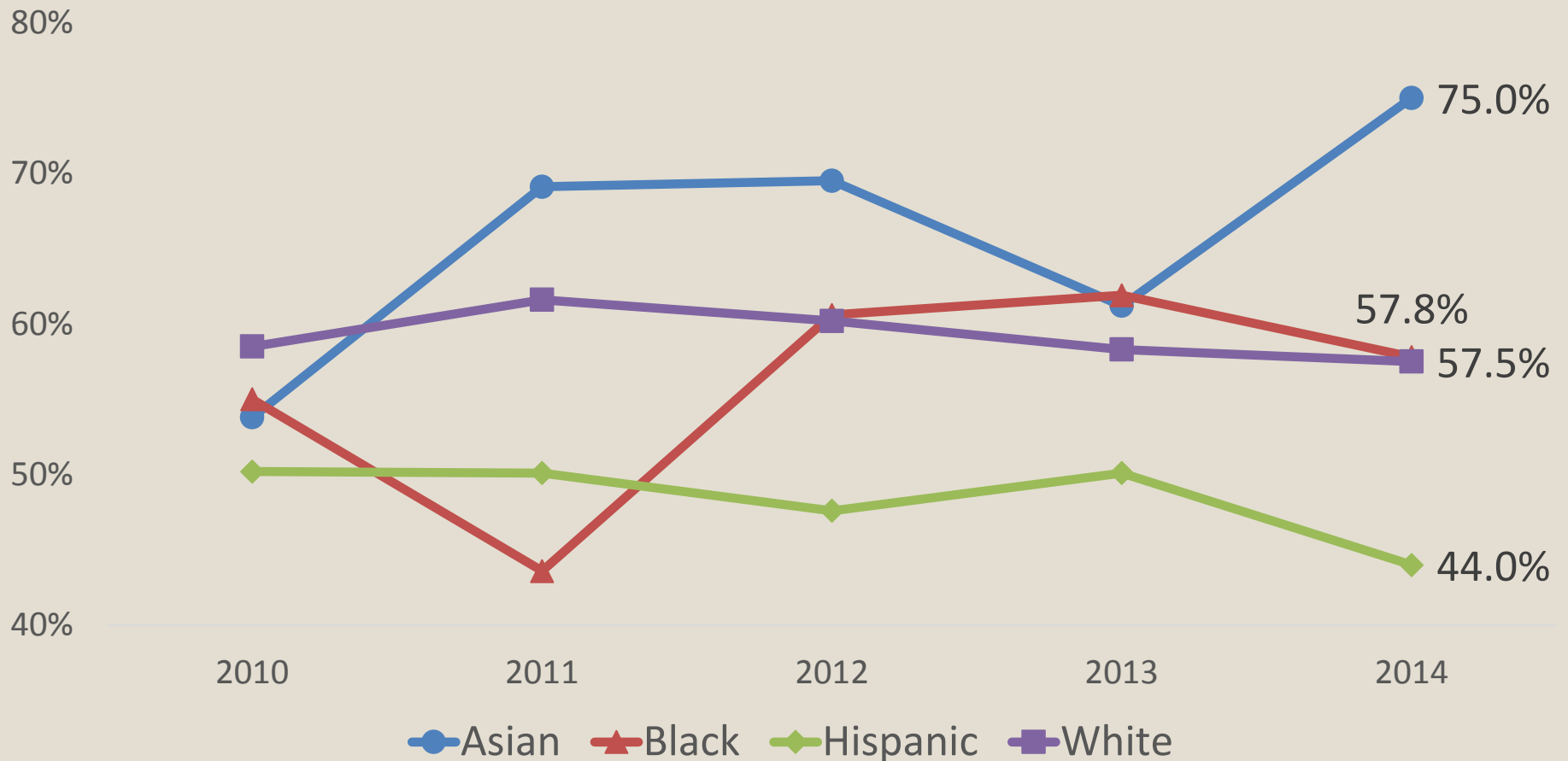
COMPLETION (DEGREE/CERTIFICATE/ TRANSFER) BY GENDER
