

APPLYING TO THE VENTURA COLLEGE NURSING PROGRAM?

Applications are accepted by appointment only. **No Walk-ins will be accepted.**

August 1 - September 15 for the September deadline, or
February 1 - March 15 for the March deadline.

1.	<p>All prerequisite courses must be completed (grades posted on transcript)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Math V03, V12, or 35(or higher level), Chemistry with lab, Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, and Current CNA certification (or proof student passed the State exam - both written and skills) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 2.5 Overall GPA (all colleges attended) ○ 2.5 GPA in Anatomy, Physiology and Microbiology ○ No more than one (1) repeat in either Anatomy, Physiology, or Microbiology
2.	<p>Applications accepted by <u>appointment only</u> during August 1 - September 15 or February 1 - March 15 (If deadline falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted up through the next business day by <u>appointment only</u>).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Official transcripts from <u>all</u> regionally accredited colleges/universities attended must be on file with the Admissions and Records Office prior to completing the Nursing Application Appointment Pre-Screening form to get cleared to schedule an appointment (contact Admission and Records to see if on file) - <i>transcripts from Ventura, Moorpark or Oxnard College not required.</i> <p><i>Official high school transcripts will be required <u>only if using chemistry from high school to apply.</u></i></p> <p><i>If official transcripts are not on file, an appointment will not be made.</i></p>
3.	<p>Go online to the Ventura College Nursing Science webpage (under application process and forms) and complete the Nursing Application Appointment Pre-Screening Form to get cleared to schedule an appointment with a Nursing Counselor to submit the Nursing Application (Please be aware that the appointments are scheduled 2 weeks in advance only.)</p>
4.	<p>Go online to the Nursing Science webpage and download the Nursing Application.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please read all requirements, complete the <i>Nursing Application</i> and <i>MultiCriteria Screening Supporting Documentation Form</i>, and collect all documentation required for multicriteria before your appointment. • The application is available at www.venturacollege.edu/departments/academic/nursing_science (or go to www.venturacollege.edu, click on Departments, click on Nursing Science, click on Admissions Process and Forms) • Link to the Nursing Application
5.	<p>On the day of your appointment please bring all of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed <i>Nursing Application</i> • Current California CNA certification (or if you have not received the certification, results from the State exam showing passed both written and skills). • Completed Multi-Criteria Screening Supporting Documentation Form - ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE SUBMITTED AT TIME OF APPLICATION. If documentation is not submitted, no multicriteria points can be awarded at the time.
6.	<p>Student will be allowed to schedule the ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) Exam after the Nursing Application has been submitted to a Nursing Counselor (if all qualifying requirements are met). Dates for the ATI TEAS exam are posted on the Nursing Science Webpage.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student's applying for the Sept 15 application deadline must have the ATI TEAS completed by October 1. • Student's applying for the March 15 application deadline must have the ATI TEAS completed by April 1.
