## **Dual Enrollment/Special Admission Guide & Checklist**

As a student enrolled at both a K-12 school and the college, the following steps are required before students are permitted to register for classes at Ventura College. We recommend you make an appointment with your school and college (*if required*) counselors early to get the necessary approvals on required paperwork. Incomplete paperwork will not be processed and will result in delayed registration.

**DUAL ENROLLMENT/SPECIAL ADMISSION STUDENTS MAY REGISTER IN A MAXIMUM OF 11.5 UNITS PER SEMESTER.** Students enrolled as dual enrollment/special admission are exempt from paying enrollment fees. All other fees apply.

CHECKLIST: Complete All applicable steps to be granted access to registration each semester.
Apply for admission to the college online at <a href="http://www.venturacollege.edu/apply">http://www.venturacollege.edu/apply</a> if this is the first time
you will be taking a college class at Ventura College or it has been more than two semesters since you last
attended class with us. Students under the age of 13 must apply in person at the Admissions & Records
Office in the Student Services Center.
Completed Recommendation for Dual Enrollment/Special Admission form with your school counselor.
Include all classes you want to register for on the form. The Recommendation form must be signed by
your school counselor.
Signed Memorandum of Understanding. Read and sign the form. Signature from the parent and student
are required.
Unofficial transcript. An unofficial transcript can be obtained from your counselor or Registrar. The
transcript may also be used to qualify you for courses with certain prerequisites.
Home Schooled Students must include a copy of the completed Private School Affidavit.
Students registering for courses in person must show a valid photo ID at the time of registration and
submit an Add card with the courses listed on the Recommendation form. If registering in person, the
student must be present. No registration by proxy will be permitted.
College class prerequisites are enforced. Check the online schedule of classes or the college catalog to
see if there are any courses required before you can take the course you want to register for now.
Students in 8th grade or lower must have written permission from the college instructor prior to being able to register.

All steps must be completed each semester the student attends Ventura College as Dual
Fnrollment/Special Admission.
