

### **Inquiry Based Learning (Can be done in any class on any topic)**

- 1) Place a provocative or significant statement, quote, or picture up
- 2) Put students in groups (2-4)
- 3) Have the group come up with as many questions as possible about the topic. (don't think-just write them all down)
- 4) Group makes all questions open ended (cannot be answered with a yes or no)
- 5) Group rates the questions to your liking
- 6) Group share the top 3 questions

#### What to do with the questions?

- Questions can be used as research topic questions.
- Questions can be used as short answer exam questions.
- Questions can be used as discussion points during the unit studied
- Questions can be themes for future lectures/lessons
- Questions can be put on the board using sticky notes and grouped by like questions. Then each group can pick up a pile and use it to write a paper or short description that discusses or answers the questions
- What else can you do with the questions?
