- Students will examine the connection between reading and writing and apply appropriate, theory-based techniques for helping students develop effective reading skills.
- Students will demonstrate effective methods of tutoring writing and reading to learning-disabled students and students of diverse linguistic backgrounds.
- Students will plan and conduct tutoring sessions using student-centered communication strategies.
- Students will apply effective strategies for dealing with plagiarism, tutoring at a computer, or tutoring online.
