

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



DATE	National/CCCCO/District
2/27	California Community College Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) sent a memo to the field with links to CA Department of Public Health and the notification that public events are not recommended for cancelation at this time
3/9	<u>Chancellor Gillespie wrote a message</u> to all students, faculty, and staff informing them of no current school closures in the county but COVID cases are expected to rise. The District is maintaining close contact with state and county officials. Information was shared related to <u>social distancing plan</u> .
3/11	CCCCO issued a memo providing protocols for colleges to begin implementing to protect our institutions.
3/12	Chancellor Gillespie wrote a message that <u>VCCCD</u> is transitioning to virtual and alternative modalities of learning <u>beginning on Monday, March 16.</u> The county continued to have no positive cases at the time.
3/14	President Trump declared a national state of emergency. <u>CCCCO provided an update</u> to the field with information on state and national declaration, resources and other information.
3/16	Messages to all included that: colleges and the District office continues to be open while practicing social distancing and enhanced hygiene. No face-to-face classes were held on campuses as of Monday, March 16 Faculty were asked to use the week to move all classes and many student support services to virtual platforms. Faculty participated in needed trainings and access available support in order to have face-to-face classes moved to virtual instruction effective Monday, March 23.
3/17	VCCCD Board of Trustees held a <u>Special meeting</u> to pass a Resolution <u>Declaring Emergency Conditions</u> . All VCCCD Location have suspended all non-essential on-site functions through Friday, April 10th. Many employees are transitioning to remote work. Only employees who are required to maintain essential operations and support will be at our work locations.
3/17	Chancellor Gillespie in a note to employees stated that- In order to comply with the explicit declarations of Federal, State, and County officials and to further act in accord with the known and accepted scientific efforts to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus, the following guidelines are provided to District Managers, Supervisors, and Employees. It is desired that to the greatest extent possible, District operations are accomplished by having employees work remotely from home (telecommute) beginning Monday, March 16 through Friday, April 10. This may extended depending upon the COVID-19 situation and local circumstances.
3/19	Governor Newsom Issued Stay at Home Order

3/13	Message to VC students about-planning for the event of a partial or full campus closure, to prevent the transmission of the Coronavirus (COVID19) should it be determined that our students will be better served by limited contact with others on our campus
3/15	VC Foundation closed the Marketplace. One hundred percent of the Foundations operating costs and part of their student support funds are raised through proceeds from the Marketplace. A prolonged closure will have a unfortunate impact on their operations and ability to support our college and students. In you are able, please consider supporting the VC Foundation with an unrestricted gift.
3/16	First Pirate Crew update which continue to happen daily during the work/instructional days.
3/16	Distributed the "Main Campus and VC East Campus Operational and Education Emergency Plan for Preventing the Spread of Infectious Diseases" to the campus in an update email.
	In this same update, faculty were information about the " <u>Campus Continuity</u> " site for information on how they can continue serving students virtually.
3/16	Enacted a Ventura College Blanket Distance Education Addendum with the CCCCO to offer all of our courses online for the remainder of the spring semester.
3/18	First Ventura College meeting of their Emergency Operations Center (EOC). We continue to meet weekly during this emergency.
3/25	Submitted proposal to Ventura County Public Health (VCPH) for our Critical Infrastructure Workforce Programs to be allowed to continue their industry training experiences. This was approved on 3/31 and classes are to resumes after spring break on 4/13 for nursing, EMT/Paramedic, CNA, and Police Academy.
3/31	Zoom Koffee with Kim event to keep individual employees informed and provided a venue for questions.


