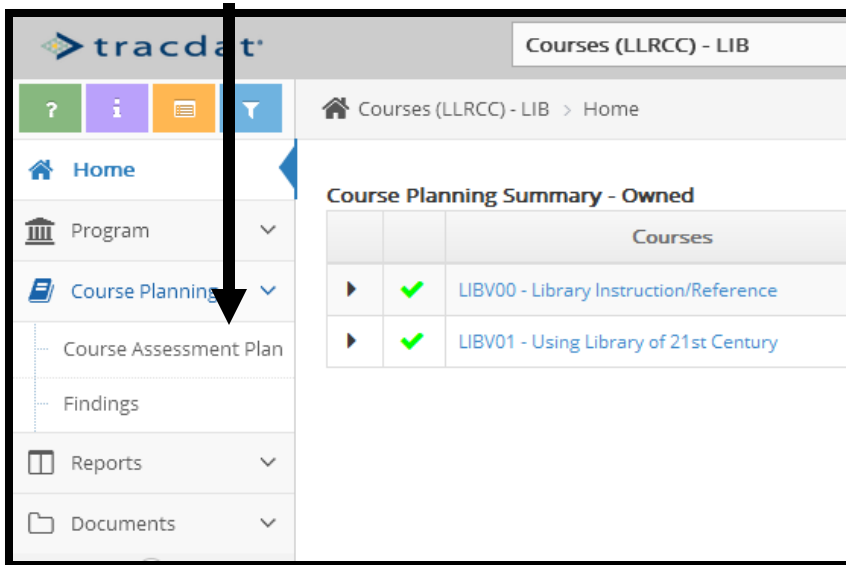
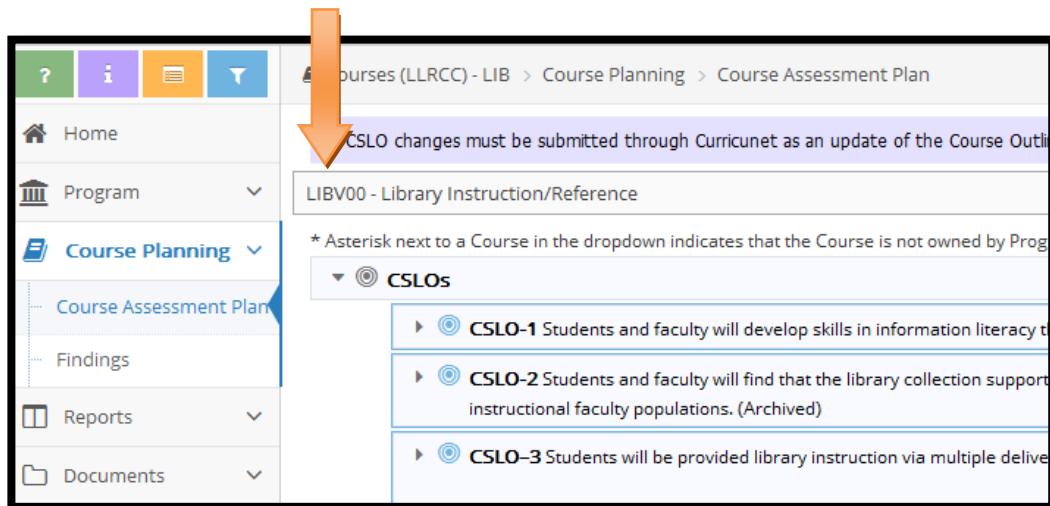



SETTING AN ASSESSMENT CYCLE FOR AN SLO

1. Go to your **Courses Unit**.
2. Click on the **Course Planning** menu.
3. Click on **Course Assessment Plan**.



4. Select a Course (**orange arrow**).



5. To set the assessment cycle, click on the **Edit** icon  next to the CSLO and set these items (see illustration on next page):
 - i. Assessment Cycle
 - ii. CSLO Status: Active
 - iii. Be sure there is a start date there. You do NOT need to change it. The date should reflect when the SLO was originally created. The date can just be approximate.
 - iv. Do not enter an Archived Date. That date is for retiring an SLO that will no longer be assessed.
 - Repeat this process for every CSLO in the course.
 - Repeat this process for the ISLO assigned to this course.
