A RESOLUTION,

Concerning the Role of the Curriculum Committee with Respect to the Establishment and Evaluation of Student Learning Outcomes

Whereas, placing students at the center of the educational experience is a core component of the Ventura College mission statement; and

Whereas, Sections 53200 et seq. of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations delegate to the Ventura College Academic Senate the responsibility for policy development and implementation of curriculum; and

Whereas, the Ventura College Academic Senate (as stipulated in Article IV, Section B of the Senate By-Laws) has further delegated authority over the review of curricular and programmatic submissions to the campus Curriculum Committee; and

Whereas, the 2014 Accreditation Standards published by Ventura College's regional accrediting body (ACCJC) include a requirement (Standard

II.A.3) to include CSLOs on its current and approved Course Outlines of Record (CORs); and

Whereas, Ventura College has established (through its participatory governance process) the Student Learning Outcomes Advisory Group (SLOAG) to review the appropriateness of Course, Program, and Institutional Student Learning Outcomes (CSLOs, PSLOs, and ISLOs, respectively); and

Whereas, the Ventura College Curriculum Committee (through its Charter) has designated a voting membership position on the Curriculum Committee to be filled by a member of the SLOAG, in part to ensure that CSLOs listed on every COR are congruent with the corresponding CSLOs documented in TracDat or other such SLO repository as may be adopted by Ventura College or the VCCCD; and

Whereas, both the Ventura College Curriculum Committee and the SLOAG recognize the separate but valuable addition that CSLOs contribute to CORs; therefore be it

Resolved, that the Ventura College Curriculum Committee affirms that its roles, accomplished in part via timely review of curricular and programmatic submissions, are to ensure that the curricula and programs of the college are academically sound, comprehensive, and responsible to the evolving needs of the community, and that the college's mission, goals, values, and educational delivery modalities continue to serve our students well; and be it further

Resolved, that the Ventura College Curriculum Committee's only roles with respect to CSLOs and PSLOs shall be to ensure that said SLOs are present on curricular and programmatic submissions, and that CSLOs/PSLOs on submitted proposals are the same as those CSLOs/PSLOs listed in TracDat or any successor SLO repository the College/District may adopt.
