AY 2013–2014: Number of Degrees and Certificates Awarded

■ **INTRODUCTION**

In **academic year 2013 – 2014**, Ventura College awarded **1,234** associate degrees and **617** certificates, for a total of **1,851** degrees and certificates (**Table A**). These degrees and certificates were awarded to **1,673** students (**Table B**); the **1,234** associate degrees were awarded to **1,085** students (**Table B**).

Fifty-four percent (54%) of the **1,673** students who received a degree and/or certificate were **Hispanic**; **62%** were **female**; and **65%** were **25 years** of age or younger.
