Budget Information

Please refer to the attached budget summary document from the CCCCO that provides an overview of the impact of the January revisions to the Governor's budget on community colleges. The budget for community colleges is increasing again; however, this is directed into specific categorically funded areas and not into the general operating budgets.

However, we may need to use one-time dollars to bridge until recurring dollars are available for some estimated new expenses next year. These new expenses are mainly estimates for salary and benefits increases
