5. Cranium Café Presentation	Cranium Café is a platform for VC counselors (currently Brandon only) to meet face-to-face with students over webcam.  Operates similarly to ConferZoom, but provides more data and analytics and live closed captioning (very thorough/accurate).  Advertised via the student portal, VC counseling web page, VC DE website and at the front desk of the counselling center  • Functions best with Chrome browser  • Students make own appointments online  • When making the appointment, students complete a brief Google form so counselor can prepare  • There is an FAQ section where students can determine whether or not they need to see a counselor  • Also allows an online version of drop-by counselling  • Document upload and screen sharing capabilities (screen sharing also works with iPhone)	Brandon

	<ul> <li>Is FERPA compliant and is currently free to college because of participation in OEI</li> <li>Has the same feel of face-to-face counseling – equally effective</li> <li>Email inquiry still exists - has not been replaced by Cranium Café (students send an email to the counseling center and a response is sent within 24 hours).</li> <li>Canvas link does not currently work with Cranium Café. Matt to follow up with Canvas team.</li> <li>Wait to link with Canvas when more counselors are trained to use it. In the meantime, online instructors can direct students to the counseling page from their Canvas shell to promote the online counseling capability.</li> <li>Brandon currently has appointments available from 7:45 – 8:30 am Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Suggestion to add 'a.m.' to appointments times posted.</li> <li>Brandon to reach out to his Department Chair about extending the number of online counseling hours to 6 and if more are approved, will assist in identifying other counselors who can be trained to use Cranium Café.</li> <li>Working to educate students on appointment etiquette e.g. cancellations.</li> </ul>	
MC DE Summit Debrief	<ul> <li>Feedback on MC Summit: <ul> <li>Auditorium not intimate – ideally the size of the venue should be commiserate with the number of attendees</li> <li>Positive feedback on 3 minute presentations. In future, change 3 minute sessions to 5 minutes to allow more time for questions and transitions</li> <li>Student panel was popular, particularly the opportunity for faculty to ask panelists unscripted questions</li> <li>8:30-12:45 time worked well so participants could leave before lunch, if they want to</li> <li>Student panelists impressed to hear how much time and effort faculty are putting in to online courses</li> </ul> </li> <li>VC to host next Summit in Spring 2019.</li> <li>Add an 'Ask the Experts' themed faculty panel to the next Summit?</li> </ul>	Ali
OER	Survey of students across several states indicate the percentage of students who purchase a textbook is close to 40%. This information provides another example of how important OER resources are.  OER Task Force rekindled? DE3 working with Kaela and the library.	Ali/Sharon
OEI	OEI mini-grant program going forward. \$500 mini-grants awarded to faculty members who complete the OEI process. OEI – first 3 students enrolled from other colleges; 2 in Economics and 1 in Sociology Courses at other schools open now as well. OEI courses are distinguished by CRNs, but are in the same Canvas shell as the VC CRN course, for convenience.	Sharon/Ara
