## IMPORTANT

Before disciplines or service areas may begin this year's activities, they must first play "catch-up" on all assessment activities from the previous cycle.



REVIEW & REFLECT

September through November

# STAGE ONE: REVIEW & REFLECT

A packet for each program and service area will be provided to department chairs and coordinators by the beginning of September

FACULTY will review each CSLO within all courses and PSLO within the program for measurability, appropriateness and determine revisions if necessary.

SERVICE AREA PERSONNEL will review each SUO within the program for measurability, appropriateness and determine revisions if necessary

**NOTE:** Revisions may include rewrites of student leaning outcomes or changing the rubric, tools, and/or standards.



### STAGE ONE: REVIEW & REFLECT TIMELINE: October & November



- A form will be completed documenting the necessary actions to be taken by the discipline/program or service area
- Packets must be submitted to department chairs by mid October, signed by the dean and returned to SLOAG
- SLOAG will review all forms and SLO's/SUO's/PSLO's and return to departments and service areas with suggestions for change where appropriate
- Department chairs and coordinators must sign and return with a plan of action

# IMPORTANT

All changes must go through the curriculum process!!



You may not change SLO's in TracDat until revisions are approved by Curriculum Committee.





# New courses offered for the <u>first time</u> in Fall 2017

will be assessed in the 2018 five-year cycle.

#### New courses offered **BEFORE** FALL 2017

must complete all assessment before setting new cycle

## STAGE TWO: UPDATE TRACDAT

TIMELINE: End of January to mid February

- Archive outdated CSLO's/SUO's and rubrics in TracDat.
- Input and upload new revised CSLO's/SUO's and rubrics into TracDat
- Department chairs will meet for Data Day so we may assist getting new and revised SLO's/SUO's into Curricunet
- We will request the Curriculum Team review all new/revised SLO's in one block and approve at one time in Spring





## RESET

February through March

## STAGE THREE: **RESET**

TIMELINE: February through end of March

- Set new five-year cycle in TracDat (2018 to 2023)
- Departments and service areas discuss methods to identify and document SLO/SUO discussions
- Each department and service area will discuss how to assess in a unified way.
- Create rubrics and identify a common assessment tool for each CSLO/SUO
