Teaching assignments

 There are two new part-time CJ instructors on-board this semester; Matt Harvill, retired Ventura County District Attorney Investigator and Mike Lazarus, in-service Santa Barbara PD. Welcome to VC and the CJ Department!

Productivity

- o The number of students enrolled in a class. Campus wide productivity goal is *500 based on a formula set by the district. CJ is currently at 429. The amount of money that our division and department will receive for equipment, materials, student activities, remodels and a variety of other things will partially be based on productivity. See program review below.
- * At the meeting Ted said the productivity goal was 525 and we were at 409. Those numbers have been adjusted as of **8-17-16.** Our productivity average for the last 4 years was 404 with a high of 411 and a low of 397. We are beginning the 16-17 school year at 429! Hopefully we can get those numbers up over the next 2 weeks.

Low enrolled classes

Due to low enrollment 5 classes from this semester's CJ offerings were cancelled, with a
possibility of one or two more. This is partially due to productivity. In the past a 35
student class would be allowed to continue with 15 students. This semester we found
that number raised to 20 for most classes.

• SLOs

- Are assessed every semester. This semester 6 courses were specified in our 5-year plan to have one SLO assessed in each of them. Due to past low enrollments in 4 of these 6 classes they were not offered this year.
- We will be assessing CJ V08 and V28. We will possibly be adding CJ V85 and V86, and possibly POSC V01 and V01A this semester (the academy and the academy orientation, there is some question if those two can be done since they are still not formally in our college catalog).
- The specific SLOs to be assessed were distributed at this meeting and they will be redistributed to the effected instructors soon.

• Department chair

- This will be Ted Prell's last semester as Department Chair. Later on in the semester there will be a meeting to elect a new department chair for spring 2017. Ted will be nominating Laz Salinas and Richard will be seconding that nomination.
- Anyone else that may be interested in being department chair should be sure to attend the meeting to express their interest. The meeting announcement of time and date will be sent via email and any other required notification methods.

Budget sources

- o Program Review will be a source for money and will be directly related to productivity and SLOs.
