■ **OVERALL BASIC SKILLS**

Institutional Objective 1 – Increase the “Improvement Rate for Basic Skills Courses”

By **September 2012**, increase by **5 percentage points** over the 2003 – 06 three-year average of **48.4%**, the Ventura College Improvement Rate for Credit Basic Skills Courses as reported in the ARCC (**10.3%** increase) *Baseline: http://www.cccco.edu/divisions/tris/rp/ab_1417/ab_1417.htm*

Goal: By **ARCC 2012**, Basic Skills Improvement Rate will be **53.4%** (**48.4%** + **5.0** percentage points)

The “Improvement Rate for Credit Basic Skills Courses” is published in the Chancellor’s Office *Accountability Reporting for the Community Colleges (ARCC)*. Cohorts consist of students who were enrolled in a credit basic-skills English or Mathematics course and who successfully completed that initial course. Cohorts are followed across three academic years (including the year and term of the initial course). The percentage of students, in each cohort, who complete a higher-level course in the same discipline within three years is the “Basic Skills Improvement Rate.”

▪ **ENGLISH OBJECTIVES**

• **Activity Objective 5 – Increase Hispanic Student Success Rate in New Strategies ENGL V02**

In **Years 2 – 5** of the grant, for student cohorts participating in the Title V new strategies pilots for **ENGL 02**, the successful completion rate for **Hispanic** students will be at least **60%**, compared to fall 2006 baseline of **40%**

• **Institutional Objective 4 – Improve Progress Rates of ENGL V02 Hispanic Students**

By **spring 2012**, for student cohorts participating in Title V new strategies pilots for **ENGL 02**, successful completion rate for Hispanic students will be at least **60%**, compared to the fall 2006 baseline of **40%**, with minimum progression rate to **next term enrollment** in **ENGL 01A** of **65%**.

Note: The goal of Activity Objective 5 is also included as one of the goals of Institutional Objective 4. Therefore, the results for both objectives are reported in the table below.

• **Activity Objective 6 – Hispanic Success Rate in CTE-Linked ENGL V02**

In **Years 4 – 5** of the grant, **Hispanic** students participating in theme-based Career Technology Education (CTE)-linked **English 02** courses during **2011 and 2012**, will successfully complete the course at a rate at least 25% greater than the fall 2006 English 02 baseline of 40% (an increase to 50%).

• **Activity Objective 7 –**

Progress of Generation 1.5 Students from Pilot Activities Classes to ENGL V02 or ENGL V01A

Participants in pilot activities designated for Generation 1.5 students will **progress to (enroll in)** a college-level English course (English 02 or 01A) after **pilot course completion**, at a rate of **40%** in **Spring 2010**, **45%** in **Spring 2011** and **55%** in **Spring 2012**. Because the college does not currently identify this target group, and such pilot programs do not yet exist, there is no baseline.

Note: “Pilot activities” for Generation 1.5 students were offered in several ENGL V03 classes.

▪ **MATHEMATICS OBJECTIVES**

• **Activity Objective 2 – Success Rate in MATH V01A**

Beginning in **fall 2009** (Year 2 of the grant), the success rate (success being defined as a grade notation of A, B, C or credit) of **all** students taking the **first** “new strategies Math 01 module” (Math 01A) will be **10** percentage points higher than the success rate of **all** students taking a “traditional Math 01” course in the same semester.

Notes: (a) To be counted, a MATH V01A enrollment must have **positive attendance** hours in Banner.
(b) **MATH V01A** was **not** offered in **spring 2012**.

Summary of Grant Objectives Requiring Student Outcomes Data

• **Institutional Objective 2 – Progression through Pre-College Algebra Sequence**

By **2012**, the progression rate from Math 01 to Math 03 for **all** students completing the **last module** of “*new strategies Math 01*” (Math 01E) will increase to **38.75%** (which is an increase of 25%) within **four semesters**, compared to the 2003–2005 baseline rate of 31% for Math 01 students who **successfully completed** Math 03 within four semesters. In addition, the historical gap of five percentage points between the Hispanic-student four-semester progression rate and the total-student four-semester progression rate will decrease by two percentage points (that is, the Hispanic-student progression rate will increase to **35.75%**).

Note: The fall 2011 cohort **cannot** be evaluated since the objective allows **four** semesters to complete MATH V03.

• **Activity Objective 1 – Progression from MATH V01 to MATH V03 for *Transfer* Students**

Beginning in **fall 2009** (Year 2 of the grant), the progression rate from Math 01 to Math 03 for **transfer students** completing the **last module** of “*new strategies Math 01*” (Math 01E) will increase to **40%** within **four semesters**, compared to the 2003–2005 baseline rate of 31% for Math 01 students who **successfully completed** Math 03 within four semesters.

Note: The **spring 2011** and the **fall 2011** cohorts **cannot** be evaluated since the objective allows **four** semesters to complete MATH V03.
