DISCIPLINE UPDATES:

Engineering:

The Engineering Liaison Council (ELC) met last week on Thursday, October 22. During this meeting, Engineering course reviewers joined together to review submitted courses in C-ID. We expect that determinations for college submissions will be delivered shortly. In addition, Engineering faculty from across the three public higher education segments (UC, CSU, and CCC) are endorsing the use of the ENGR model curriculum (ISMC) to develop transfer pathways into individual CSU and UC campuses.

Hospitality:

A group of intersegmental Hospitality faculty met last week to discuss and draft a potential Transfer Model Curriculum (TMC) for Hotel Management. A draft of the TMC, along with draft descriptors will be available for vetting in the very near future.

Areas of Emphasis Disciplines – Social Justice Studies & Global Studies:

Both the Social Justice Studies and Global Studies faculty discipline review group (FDRG) completed the work on the Area of Emphasis TMCs for both disciplines. The TMCs are now posted on the C-ID website, under the “TMC” tab. We anticipate the CCC Chancellor’s Office templates for both will be available February 1, 2016. Descriptors were also finalized and are now available for course submissions. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

C-ID Appeal Process:

As a reminder, C-ID has an existing appeal process for colleges to initiate if they do not agree with a determination granted to a submission. This appeal process is available on the C-ID website. We have received determinations (total for approved, conditional, and not approved columns), with 14,069 courses receiving a C-ID designation (an 82% approval rate).

When C-ID is contacted by a faculty member at a college regarding questions they may have on a determination, our standard protocol is to provide an answer to the faculty member inquiring and to copy the campus Articulation Officer on our response. Our goal is to ensure that the AO is aware of any inquiries that come to C-ID. Concerns or questions from the field may also be shared directly with the Primary Reviewer. In the event that a problem with a review is identified through this process, the Primary Reviewer may initiate a determination change.

C-ID Review Process - Overview:

We recently received an inquiry regarding the reviewer process and the steps by which approvals are given for submissions. Descriptors for CCC-only Courses and Course Review:

C-ID descriptors were recently drafted and finalized for non-transfer courses. The discipline descriptors are marked with a suffix “X” to demarcate that the courses are intended for use only within the CCC system (intra-segmental) and were developed by CCC faculty only. They are also marked with “-CCC” on the finalized listing of C-ID descriptors (found [here](#)). A team consisting of CCC faculty only will review courses submitted for descriptors with the “X” suffix. In the future, should the descriptors become intersegmental, then the descriptors will have to go through the intersegmental review process and approved courses may require resubmission if changes are made to the descriptors. Submission of non-transfer courses for CCC-only Descriptors:

As you know, courses submitted for C-ID is first validated against the existing courses in ASSIST otherwise the submission is not allowed for C-ID. We are aware that courses that may be submitted for CCC-only descriptors could be transferrable or non-transferrable, and that traditionally, non-transferable courses are not included in ASSIST. We are currently working on a technology update to allow courses not in the ASSIST database to be submitted for CCC-only descriptors. We hope to work through this during the rest of December and January and anticipate to have this resolved around February 2016.

You can still submit courses for the CCC-only descriptors if the courses are currently in ASSIST – submit them as normal.

Hello,

I am writing to document and share the course change requests we received at DTRW-I this week, so that appropriate action may be taken in a timely manner.

1. With regard to DM V10L and DM V12L, the workgroup asked us to provide more substantial catalog descriptions for these lab courses. As a note for future technical review criteria, the catalog description for a lab course should be able to stand on its own, rather than relying on the verbiage from the affiliated lecture course. Andy and Ryan, may I trouble you please to work together to add some summary content information to the catalog descriptions in Curricunet for the DM labs? Please note that Andy will not be able to edit the outlines unless they are sent back to an earlier step in the Curricunet approval track, so this work will need to be coordinated with someone having administrative rights in Curricunet (e.g., Ryan or Katie). (As an alternative, Andy could simply email the enhanced catalog information to Ryan or Katie for insertion into Curricunet.) Katie, we should not send these courses to the board until we have the new catalog descriptions in place; my recommendation is to hold all four DM courses so they may be sent forward as a group. This work should be deemed high-priority, as there are strong incentives for us to be able to offer these courses beginning fall 2016.

2. I recommended using a non-abbreviated title for DM V12L, to which there was general agreement. I will fix this in Curricunet. Katie, please use the updated title when you prepare the board packet for this course. As a general technical review criterion, the short title may be abbreviated (the short title is the version of the course title which is printed on student transcripts, so space limitations are necessary to keep the transcripts concise), but the catalog title should be stated in full except in unusual circumstances.

3. With regard to the AUTO labs V26L, V33L, V38L, for any of these which are replacing old ...LA/...LB sequences, we were asked to specify both ...LA and ...LB as former course IDs in the catalog. I know that in the past Connie has told us we could only specify one predecessor course ID, but when I brought this up at the meeting, several representatives from both Moorpark and Oxnard seemed to think it was possible to specify two or more "formerly" course IDs per course when applicable. Rationale: because there is a board member who is adamantly against unit increases, it will be harder to present these lab courses at BoT because it looks like we are increasing units from 1 to 1.5 when we are really decreasing units from 2 to 1.5. So adding information to the catalog supporting the concept that the new labs are decreasing from

2 units' worth of courses rather than increasing from 1 units' worth would apparently be beneficial in terms of reducing potential BoT scrutiny. The workgroup recommended that Ornpawee should contact Kim Watters regarding how to accomplish this in Banner so the "formerly"

information may transfer to the data appended to the catalog description. (Andy, this is an administrative issue; no action on your part is required.)

4. The workgroup recommended that BUS V94 not be forwarded to BoT because the title change was considered non-substantial. Katie, please omit this course from the BoT packet, and process/finalize it as a campus-level approval instead. The workgroup also suggested that this course's instructional modes be reviewed by the originating department (Debbie?) as it seemed at least some of the activities were more appropriate for lab rather than lecture, thus potentially allowing the unit count to be reduced at the course's next revision without necessarily reducing weekly contact hours. It would be helpful to have feedback from the business department to present at the next DTRW-I meeting if there is good cause to continue offering this as a lecture-only course; however, we were not specifically asked to modify the course at this time.

Katie, could you please append a copy of this message to the next CC meeting packet for reference when we give the DTRW-I report in January?

All, please let me know if you have questions or require clarification regarding the above requests.
