He stated that an amendment is needed to include the Academic Senate President as an ex officio voting member. A. Kolesnik confirmed that the Academic Senate Bylaws supersede those of Curriculum Committee.

Discussion: *R. Koerner presented the course and noted that it is required for the proposed ADT in Public Health Science. The revisions were based on feedback from C-ID. Fully online was added as an option. M. Bowen stated that the AO's written recommendation, for all courses in general, was to establish a practice of listing more than one textbook on CORs. The reason provided was that if a particular text goes out of print, or an instructor wants to use something different. The AO wrote that it is something to consider for the future, but not necessary to add at this time.*

Bowen replied that the hours were similar to our Art courses. M. Bowen shared the AO's written comments regarding the hours and an inquiry if there would be further sequence courses to these two, a 'C' and/or 'D', and a suggestion to establish a family with stage makeup. G. Lewis-Huddleston addressed the comments and replied in the affirmative regarding the additional courses and noted that a family would be incongruent in this case.

K. Hoffmans conveyed that the topic of unit creep has come up at DTRW-I. She stated that the concern is regarding enrollment, a student would pay for 3 units, faculty would get paid for 4 hours, and it is not normal Carnegie units. She stated her awareness that this is a hot topic and she was not asking for a decision but that it is considered during deliberation. P. Sezzi noted that the units were not changed. K. Hoffmans noted that what the student pays for would be what we would get from the state but faculty would get paid an extra hour. A brief discussion ensued regarding impact to students

He shared that concern was raised regarding the 7 units for MATH V19, considering our sister college approved the same course at 6 units. He shared that the proposal for early registration with implementation for fall 2016 has been postponed until fall 2017.
