Discussion: The course was presented as a core requirement for the ADT in English. An inquiry was made regarding the ENGL V01C created specifically for the ADT. That course was not approved for GE. It was noted that the proposal aligns with our sister colleges. It was confirmed that the plan was to propose a deletion for ENGL V01C.

M. Bowen noted that Letrisha Mai, Articulation Officer at Moorpark College, endorses this approach.
