#### V. POLICY AND PROCESS (Information or Discussion/Action)

##### A. GE Pattern (Discussion/Action if needed) – T. Brabander (20 min)

T. Brabander presented a proposal to modify GE requirements for some degrees. If pattern were to change it would have to be done across the district. Proposal would have to go to DTRW-I, Chancellor's Cabinet, and the Board to change the AP/BPs

Counseling faculty from 3 colleges have gotten together to create this proposal while still being within the requirements for Title 5.

*T. Brabander proposed a motion to recommend the alternative GE pattern for CTE and STEM students to DTRW-I.*

*Seconded by: D. Clark*

*Discussion: Thao presented a PowerPoint regarding the proposal and discussion followed. Areas that have asterisks are considered CTE – areas that are being considered are the ones with the asterisk on the TOPS codes. Certain STEM majors but not all? What's the criteria? ADTs are not on the list. For a student who transfers, they'll follow their own IGETC or CSU GE pattern. District workgroup created this proposal – brought up in an Articulation Officer (AO) meeting, 3 AOs took it back to campuses and discussed. High units affect financial aid, enrollment, completion.*

*Concern: Idea has moved from high unit majors to CTE and STEM. Migration could cause some questions with the lower unit CTE programs. Some majors are as low as 18 units. Concern is that students may take courses that aren't going to help them as much in their careers due to the freedom in electives.*

*Response: This presentation is the first time it is being presented to the three colleges. Previous information discussions regarding this proposal (like in a Tech Review meeting) may have been during the work in progress. High unit majors are not a factor. This concerns some CTE and STEM majors.*

*To guide students in choosing appropriate elective courses, departments can change verbiage in the catalog with course suggestions, etc.*

*Kin/Health Dept: Please not to remove area E from GE list as movement is important.*

*Concern: Identification of the STEM courses – not all are listed.*

*Response: Proposal follows the TOPs list and Title 5 information.*

*Suggestion: Before approval, can the committee get a report that shows how the double counting works rather than just judging them on the number of units listed in the catalog? Some are not comfortable with how we're designating the 2 different GE patterns against one another.*

*Requesting a report on double counting for majors between 30 and 40 units.*

*Concern over the purpose of GE in the first place. What is the point? Isn't part of our function educating future citizens with well-rounded courses?*

*Response: This would help certain major attain an Associates Degree instead of just stopping at the certificate. Counseling department believes this new pattern won't really affect our "typical" students, but will help CTE students.*

*Percentage of student population affected by this? Is that known? That would be helpful to know for further discussion.*

## Rules of Decorum for Professional Meetings

Excerpted from Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised (11<sup>th</sup> edition)  
and the Ralph M. Brown Act

- I. How and When to Speak
  - a. Before a member may make a motion or speak in debate, he/she must obtain the floor. A member has not obtained the floor until recognized by the chair (Robert, p. 29).
  - b. To make a motion, the usual wording begins with "I move that..." or "I move the adoption of the following resolution..." (p. 33). To second a motion, it is not necessary to obtain the floor; it is sufficient to say, "I second the motion" or "Second!" (p. 35).
  - c. Members should address all remarks through the chair, not the body or other members. (p. 392).
  - d. A member desiring to ask a question of the member who is speaking should also address the chair. Example: "Mr./Ms. Chair, I would like to ask the member a question." The member speaking is not obligated to respond, or may elect to defer (pp. 293–294).
- II. Rules of Debate (Robert, pp. 43–44 and pp. 392–394)
  - a. A member's remarks must be germane to, and limited to the merits of, the question before the body, and must be addressed to the chair.
  - b. A speaker may speak against the likely consequences of a proposed measure in strong terms, but must maintain a courteous tone, must avoid injecting a personal note into the debate, and must not attack, question, or allude to the motives of another member. The measure, not the member, is the subject of debate.
  - c. Accusing a member of making a false statement is never appropriate. In the event of disagreement, one may say something like, "I believe there is strong evidence that the member is mistaken."
  - d. No one shall be permitted to disturb the assembly (e.g., by whispering or holding a side conversation in a manner that makes it difficult for members to hear the debate).
  - e. The presiding officer must never interrupt a speaker simply because he or she knows more about a matter than the speaker does.
- III. Duties of the Chair (Robert, pp. 449–450)
  - a. To call the meeting to order, ascertain that a quorum is present, announce the proper sequence of business, recognize members who are entitled to the floor, and declare the meeting adjourned at its conclusion.
  - b. To state and put to vote questions (motions or resolutions) that come before the body.
  - c. To enforce the rules relating to debate, order, and decorum.
  - d. To expedite business in a manner compatible with the rights of members.
  - e. To decide all questions of order, or to submit such questions to the body for a decision, and to respond to inquiries of members regarding parliamentary procedure or factual questions related to the business of the body.
- IV. Other Rules
  - a. All persons at a meeting have an obligation to obey the legitimate orders of the presiding officer. This includes responding to a call to come to order (Robert, pp. 645–646).
  - b. If the body is subject to the Brown Act, the public's right to testify at a regular meeting includes the right to criticize the policies, procedures, programs, or services of the agency, or the acts or omissions of the body (Gov. Code, § 54954.3(c)).
  - c. In the case of disorderly behavior, the body has the right to exclude any non-member or group of non-members who willfully cause a disruption of the meeting (Gov. Code, § 54957.9; Penal Code, § 403; Robert, p. 644).
