V. POLICY AND PROCESS (Information or Discussion/Action)

A. SLO Review (Discussion) - N. Cole (5 min)

Process was delayed due to the fire. Andrea Horrigan has stepped down as cofacilitator. Everything is back on track now. One concern: a lot of disciplines and/or service areas have new SLOs or have revised SLOs. Can we approve all of them at once in the curriculum process? Is this possible? There would be hundreds of courses.

Suggestion: Could put this as a Consent Agenda item for "SLO review – non catalog changes". This won't change 5-year review cycle. Those courses that have catalog changes would go through the normal process. Should be clearly noted on any agenda(s). Question: Do we copy the course to add changes, or do we change existing course and lose that information in CurricUNET? Old SLOs will be available in TracDat. Consensus was that logistically, it would make more sense to update existing course (not make a full new copy).

On a course, there is an SLO box which can be checked as a trigger that the course has been edited. Notes could read: "historical SLOs notated in TracDat".

List of courses that have SLO updates would be needed for Curriculum Committee Agenda and voting. Content is not needed as it is not the Curriculum Committee's purview to review SLOs.


If you think your course meets the GE requirement, please submit it to the Curriculum Committee. If it already approved for local GE, there is a good chance it will be approved at the university level.
