COUN V01 - College Success

This course is all about student wellness, mental health, how to help students prepare for the rigors of learning at a college level. Emotional intelligence, self-help. It would help to align the CSU GE list and our local GE list. Would like to submit this course to be approved for local GE – it has already been accepted as GE at CSU.

Suggestion – catalog description may need to be re-written. Current version is brief and it doesn't seem to provide any study in mental health. There is no pressing reason why the CSU GE needs to align with our local GE. Final Recommendation:

Group recommends course for area E1 on our local GE list for 2017/2018, but with a request/recommendation that the catalog description should be revised.

EAC V01 – Strategies for Success in College and Life

Has mental health aspects within the course, holistic health aspects. Course is mostly designed to address the needs of students with disabilities, but it is not unique to those students. There is a correlation between this course and COUN V01.

Final Recommendation:

Group recommends course for Area E1 on our local GE list for 2017/2018

COUN VO2 - Career Exploration and Life Planning

Students are the subject matter of this course. They learn about themselves as a whole being. Counseling is a derivative of Psychology and Sociology. They learn about theories and the application of these theories to understand themselves. Understanding industry sectors, the "world of work", career development. Course is centered on the student coming up with their own conclusions about their career. All the smaller areas are encompassed in the career theory aspect. Local high school students are currently taking this course. Final Recommendation:
