#### I. Procedures

If we make a recommendation here, the department involved should be notified in case they have any concerns/questions. Some courses are already approved, and will be discussed with Thao when that item is discussed.

Thao is asking for permission to change the language and bring it to the Curriculum Committee, DTRW-I, and possibly the Board for agreement/cohesiveness with all three campus catalogs.
	Modification of the motion was made – to bring the motion forward so there can be DAC legal assistance to strengthen the language. Thao will help to develop the language with the other AOs. Suggestion was made to look at other District catalogs for examples of their language. "Addendums" or "subsequent publications" should be mentioned in the updated language.

	What's the harm of them using the course now to complete the degree? We don't have a policy to address our own mistake. We don't want to put the student at a disadvantage.
	K. Hoffmans: We have the obligation to honor our catalog and if we left that in there even as a
	mistake, I feel bound to err on the side to benefit the student. Many of the group agreed.
	Counseling, Damien, Kim to get together to come up with "norming sessions" for general understandings focused in the same direction.
	Course will be removed from the list when an addendum is published.
