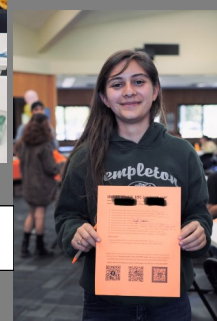
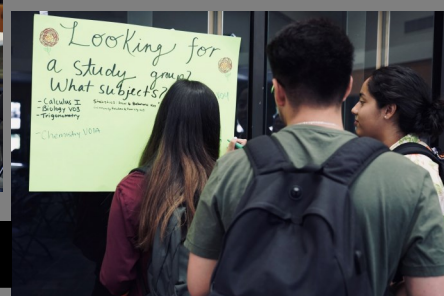

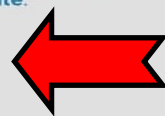
El periodo de aplicación de la beca es
