How to accept a UC admissions of

You can accept an admission offer by agreeing to the provisions/conditions outlined in the offer and submitting your Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) with the SIR deposit to reserve your space at a campus. The SIR deposit is \$250. Some important things to keep in mind about accepting a UC admission offer:

1. You can accept only one admission offer from one UC campus.

The SIR deposit is applied to your first 2 enrollment term tuition.

- 3. Students that qualified for the UC application fee waiver will have the SIR deposit deferred until financial aid is disbursed.
- 4. The SIR deposit is nonrefundable and nontransferable.
- **Orientation** may be required at some 5.
