

Streaming Videos



We now have two streaming video services available: <u>Swank</u> and <u>Films on Demand</u>.

Films on Demand provides access to thousands of films and film clips from producers like A&E, BBC, HBO Documentary Films, PBS, Ken Burns, National Geographic and more. Create an account to save playlists - you can even film your own intro for playlists. If you are using Canvas, add the Films on

Demand app to easily search and embed films into courses.

Swank allows you to stream major motion pictures for use in VC courses. Movies can be viewed in the classroom or linked in Canvas. VC can license up to 25 movies per semester. Faculty must create an account and submit a request for each movie they would like to license.
