Welcome to 2020!


Hope everyone had a great winter break! The library has launched its new Library Services Platform! The library website now has a new look and new search capabilities.


From the library homepage, you can now use OneSearch to search across all library resources at once. This includes print books, electronic books, and articles from all of the databases we subscribe to. You can also easily search for and request books from Oxnard College and Moorpark College.

Since this is a new system, we are still working out some of the bugs and are looking for ways to improve user experience. As you begin to use this new system, please feel free to send feedback our way!

In addition to our new website and search interface, your librarians are hard at work updating and creating new <u>video tutorials</u> and <u>library guides</u>.


Here is an example of one of our new videos which will walk you through our new website. Some of the other new videos in the works include ones introducing OneSearch, using OneSearch to search for specific types of sources and finding course reserves in OneSearch.

We are also updating many of our existing videos, including those on database search strategies, the text-book lending library, and using the e-journals search to reflect our new OneSearch system.

Our library guides are also being updated to reflect the new website and OneSearch system. The guides have embedded OneSearch search boxes along with information on how to limit searches to specific source types.

Both the videos and library guides are resources that we want to continue to grow to meet the needs of our VC community. We also hope that faculty will utilize these resources





by recommending them to their students or embedding them into their Canvas courses.
