COURSE REVIEWS/EXCHANGE PREPARATION (SPOCS: Please share this with your Pilot Faculty)

Course Review Application Due Date: Monday, May 23

Monday is the deadline for submitting your application to get your course reviewed (or rereviewed) in the next cycle.

NOTE for Full Launch Faculty: If you plan to offer your course in the fall 2016 pilot of the Course Exchange, then you need to have your course reviewed during this cycle. If you have not been told that you are aligned, then a re-review (or even a re-re-review) is needed. Your hard work and dedication to quality is recognized - **many of you are VERY close to alignment with the rubric.**

EVALUATION UPDATE

- The integrated Canvas surveys will be emailed out to faculty to send to their students in courses piloting OEI services on Monday, May 23rd. The link will be emailed to all faculty with sections that have ended or are ending. Please encourage faculty to send to their students even if the class has ended. The survey collects information about students' experience with Canvas, readiness, tutoring, and accessibility.
- A survey specifically for faculty will also be emailed by Friday, May 27th, to collect information about faculty's experiences with Canvas, readiness, tutoring, and accessibility.
- The OEI Processes Survey was deployed last week and so far we have 69 responses!
