ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

The OEI team, with guidance from the Steering Committee Academic Integrity Workgroup, has been conducting a search for a partner to provide online originality / plagiarism detection services. On Friday June 10, our search concluded with the endorsement of the Steering Committee and our posting of a Notice of Intent to Award a contract to **VeriCite, Inc.** We are working with the Foundation's CollegeBuys division to finalize the contract now.

Pilot colleges have the opportunity to participate in a one-year OEI-funded college-wide pilot of VeriCite. To participate, Vericite must be used as the exclusive plagiarism detection / originality tool. SPOCs from all 24 colleges received a request from Jory Hadsell earlier this week seeking interest. The list of participating pilot colleges is being finalized. If your college has not yet responded and would like to participate, please contact support@ccconlineed.org by Thursday, June 30th.

We anticipate beginning services under the pending contract on or around July 1 (or later, if desired by individual colleges). As an added feature, VeriCite is agreeing to provide a fully functional 90-day "trial" for CCCs. If you want to activate the trial account, it can then become the official account if you are participating in the coming pilot. Colleges can contact support@vericite.com to register for the free trial.

As a point of information for future planning purposes, we anticipate the cost to colleges (after the one-year pilot) will be \$1.05 per FTE (we are finalizing pricing and volume tiers, so it's possible this price could go lower depending on statewide volume) and we will have more exact info for you very soon.
