Your Guide to ENROLLMENT



- 1 APPLY FOR ADMISSION**
 - Access the online application at: venturacollege.edu/apply
 - Follow instructions to create an OpenCCC account and submit your application
 - You must provide a valid e-mail address
 - You can create a free e-mail account from any of the sources listed on the OpenCCC website
 - Now click on "COMPLETE" to finish your application

- 2 SETUP  ACCOUNT**
 - You will receive an email from Ventura College with instructions on how to setup your **MyVCCCD** account to register for classess
 - Regularly check your **MyVCCCD** email or activate mail forwarding option under MyAccount settings in **MyVCCCD**
 - Write down your Student ID number for your records


- 3 COMPLETE NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION**
 - Log on to **MyVCCCD** and click on the **MySuccess** tab to complete online orientation
 - Complete the short assessments and print your Certificate of Completion. It will be required prior to making a counseling appointment

- 4 COMPLETE THE ENGLISH & MATH ASSESSMENTS**
 - Assessment Center information can be found online at: venturacollege.edu/assess
 - Schedule an assessment session by submitting a **Testing Appointment Request Form**
 - Attend the testing session and complete the English & Math assessment test
 - Check for the testing dates & times, test last 2-3 hours long (805) 289-6402

- 5 DEVELOP A STUDENT EDUCATIONAL PLAN**
 - Call 805-289-6448 to schedule your New Student Counseling session and develop your 1st semester educational plan
 - Access **DegreeWorks** via **MyVCCCD** to select and track courses to meet your educational goals

- 6 APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID ONLINE AT: FAFSA.ED.GOV**
 - Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - Apply for the Board of Governors Fee Waiver (BOGW)
 - Ventura College School Code: 001334

- 7 SUBMIT OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS FROM HIGH SCHOOL AND ALL COLLEGES YOU HAVE ATTENDED.**
 - If you have attended any other college or university, arrange to have official transcript(s) sent to Ventura College after final grades are posted
 - AP test results must be sent to Ventura College directly from the College Board
 - Transcripts must be submitted in a sealed envelope
 - Mail transcripts to: **Ventura College Admissions & Records**

- 8 REGISTER & PAY ONLINE AT **
 - Verify your date & time for registration.
 - Please check the current calendar for registration dates.
 - Registration will not be complete unless the fees are paid in full.
 - Payment plans are available through Register & Pay tab.

- 9 GET YOUR VENTURA COLLEGE STUDENT ID CARD**
 - The Associated Students of Ventura College (ASVC) encourage you to purchase an ASVC Photo Identification Card. This card entitles students to many benefits that are financed largely by the funds received from membership in the ASVC. (805) 289-6156.

- 10 FOLLOW UP**
 - After the rush, schedule an appointment to meet with a counselor to develop a comprehensive Student Education Plan (SEP). Appointments are scheduled in the Counseling Office (SSC) or by calling (805) 289-6448.
