III. Action/Information/Discussion

A. Priority List and Deadlines – Update

Paulette said that 395 courses have been processed so far. Of the 395 courses submitted; a large number of them need to be relaunched. She reminded the Committee to make sure faculty members are relaunching the courses so they can be ready by November 1st. Also, she mentioned that of the 395 courses received only 87 courses are from the priority one list.

It was confirmed by the Curriculum Committee that courses that are not revised/updated from the priority list will not be offered 2011-12. Paulette will be updating the priority one list to reflect the courses that have been received. The list will be sent to the Curriculum Committee. It will also be presented at the Department Chairs Council meeting on Tuesday, September 28th and at tomorrow's Administrative Council meeting. It was also agreed by the Curriculum Committee that communication of courses in progress will be communicated to their constituents in each of their respective divisions. An update will be provided in a month to see how the communication process is working.

Paulette noted that courses going through the approval process in Curricunet should be at a level 2.0 by October 1st and level 4.0 by November 1st.

B. <u>Degree document – Discussion</u>

The document was updated by removing "recommendations" and adding "the approved date". The document will be presented to department chairs at next week's Department Chairs Council meeting.

C. Proficiency Award Sub-committee Report
